

BRYANT MONTESSORI DRESS CODE

Wearing the appropriate clothing is important so that clothes do not become a distraction from your studies. Hats, do-rags, scarves, sunglasses, cropped shirts or tank tops (one inch thick straps at a minimum), torn clothing, "sagging" pants, and ads for alcohol, drugs and violence are distracting and are inappropriate at school. Students in the elementary school are not permitted to wear make-up. Shorts, skirts and dresses should be finger-tip length.

We do not permit the use of any clothing, jewelry, or grooming styles that may indicate or imply membership or affiliation with gangs. We will not tolerate any activities that could physically or mentally harm students. Any student wearing, carrying, or displaying gang paraphernalia or who is demonstrating behavior or using gestures which symbolize gang membership or are threatening to others will be subject to serious disciplinary action. If you are dressed inappropriately, you will be asked to change.

Shoes should be worn that enable a student to fully participate in PE and other physical activities, shoes with roller blades/wheels are not permitted.
