**2010~2011 Edison Elementary Uniform Dress Code  
Kindergarten - 5<sup>th</sup> grade**

Edison Elementary requires all students to wear appropriate clothing that follow the school's guidelines. Students may wear pants that are dark blue, khaki, black. **No jeans are allowed.** Pants must fit appropriately and cannot be baggy or falling off hips and free of holes. Students are allowed to wear Edison t-shirts or Edison hoodie sweatshirts which are available for purchase from Edison's PTA. Shirts must be solid dark blue or white and may or may not have a collar. No "undershirts", must be heavier weight cotton t-shirt. Coats or outerwear may **NOT** be worn in the classrooms unless they are Edison sweatshirts. Students who wear leggings or tights must wear uniform colors.

Edison students must wear shoes that are safe and comfortable for daily exercise, P.E., and recess. **No high heels** or open back shoes are allowed such as clogs. Tennis shoes must be tied and laces the same color. **No flip flops** are allowed at school which are unsafe for inside or outside the building. Shoes must fit the student and not too large or too small for comfort.

**Edison students may NOT wear accessories such as bandanas, scarves, hats, or baseball caps. For pierced ears, students must wear stud earrings only. No hoops or dangled jewelry will be allowed. Tattoos and fake fingernails are also NOT allowed at Edison as they are not safe and disrupt the learning process.**

**Edison Elementary t-shirts and sweatshirts are available for purchase. Please call the office for prices.** We encourage students to wear their Edison clothing as it improves school pride and creates a positive environment. Research shows that schools that have dress codes show improved achievement results and decreased number of discipline incidents in the school. Wearing school uniforms eliminates the peer pressure to "out-dress" each other as well as saves money for families as they don't have to purchase trendy, name-brand clothing.

**Please remember the following:**

- \*no skirts shorter than fingertip length
- \*no tight clothing
- \*no non-uniform clothing may be seen
- \*no exposed stomachs or underwear
- \*no tank tops or halters
- \*no decorations on pants or shirts  
(glitter, flowers, designs, etc.)
- \*no company brands, logos, designs, pictures or advertisements on shirts
- \*no "baggies or sagging"
- \*no low neck shirts for girls
- no leggings that are not school colors

**If students don't follow the dress code expectations, students will receive the following consequences:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> time:** student reminder, dress code infraction notice sent home to parents
- 2<sup>nd</sup> time:** student reminder, loss of recess, parent notification
- 3<sup>rd</sup> time:** meet with school counselor
