

GRAY MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE

2010-2011

Our Gray Middle School Dress Code standards are intentionally conservative to help students focus on learning. Only the articles listed below can be worn for the Gray Middle School Dress Code. Clothing must be neat in appearance and worn appropriately. Students are to be in dress code at all times while on campus (before, during and after school).

Any type of dress or grooming which is disruptive will not be permitted.

A. TOPS - Polo shirts and crew neck sweatshirts only.

1. Solid colors: White and Navy Blue
2. T-shirts worn under polos and sweatshirts must be solid white and tucked in if longer than the outer shirt.
3. A polo shirt only may be worn under a sweatshirt for layering reasons.
4. No oversized shirts (2 or more sizes larger than body frame).
5. Shirt length must not extend below your longest finger, with arms hanging at sides.
6. No tight, revealing clothing or clothing that reveals bare torso or undergarments.

B. GRAY MIDDLE SCHOOL SWEATSHIRTS AND T-SHIRTS

1. Any Gray Middle School insignia t-shirt, polo shirt or sweatshirt purchased from the school. Any sport or club shirt, such as band or wrestling, which has been pre-approved by administration, is allowed.
2. P.E. attire will only be worn in P.E. class. Students may not wear PE clothing underneath their regular Dress Code clothing.

C. PANTS, SHORTS, CAPRIS, SKIRTS, SKORTS, JUMPERS - All are solid Navy Blue or Black slacks – no denim fabric/jeans).

1. **Must be plain in style.**
2. Slacks, capris and shorts must be securely worn at the waist. No *oversized, baggy, sagging pants. (*Oversized is any clothing 2 or more sizes larger than body frame).
3. Length of pants is to the top of the shoe hemmed, not dragging on the floor. No pants worn lower than the top of the hip bone, dragging on the floor, or overly-bunched around the ankles. Rubber bands, etc., are not allowed to bind bottom of pants.
4. Length of shorts, skirts, shorts and jumpers (including slits) must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
5. **No CARGO pants (pants with extra pockets down the leg) or added adornments (decorations, etc.). ABSOLUTELY NO LOGOS!!!!**

D. SHOES: Must be closed-toed and have backs for safety reasons. If shoes are designed to have laces, they must be tied securely and properly, and must be of correct fit. For safety reasons, shower-type sandals, flip-flops, house slippers, rubber or plastic slipper-type sandals, slides, soccer sandals, etc., are not allowed.

E. OUTERWEAR: Including jackets, coats, hooded or zipped sweatshirts, polar fleece, sweaters, gloves and hats must be kept in locker.

F. ACCESSORIES: Only small and moderate jewelry or hair accessories are allowed. Belts must be white, navy blue or black, be plain in style, and secured in belt loops. Only white, black, navy blue or flesh-colored crew-length socks or nylons or tights (no leggings) may be worn with shorts or capris (no baseball-style/knee socks). All other accessories, including sweat bands, bandanas and chains are NOT ALLOWED!!! A limit of 2 bracelets (per wrist) and 2 necklaces are allowed.

All staff members are responsible for monitoring uniform compliance.
