

## Uniform Guidelines at McCarver Elementary School

Our goal is to provide an atmosphere for learning in which no one is distracted by the appearance of our students. This list explains the uniform guidelines:

Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· polo shirts, turtlenecks, or dress shirts/blouses</li> <li>· official McCarver T-shirts</li> <li>· shirts must be tucked in at all times</li> <li>· either long or short sleeves are fine, but not sleeveless</li> <li>· colors: white, black, or navy blue</li> </ul>
pants, skirts, shorts, overalls, capris, skorts, and jumpers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· fabric will be twill, corduroy or denim (without designs), not sweatpants</li> <li>· shorts and skirts must be longer than the end of the fingers</li> <li>· must be worn at the waist with looseness of no more than one inch, and with a belt if needed (no sagging)</li> <li>· standard width leg with hemmed bottom</li> <li>· length must be to top of shoe so pants do not touch floor</li> <li>· skirts may be A-line or pleated</li> <li>· colors: navy blue, black, or khaki</li> </ul>
Sweatshirts, vests, or sweaters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· colors: solid white, navy blue or McCarver sweatshirts</li> </ul>
shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· should have a low-heel and a heel strap</li> <li>· "Heelies" are not allowed</li> </ul>
belts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· belts should not extend more than 6" past the buckle (belts cannot hang down)</li> <li>· colors: black or navy blue</li> </ul>
general appearance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· hair cuts should not be distracting</li> <li>· hair must be clean, neat, and not dyed in unnatural colors</li> <li>· facial make-up is not allowed</li> <li>· stickers or drawings on the skin are not allowed</li> </ul>
