

McKinley Elementary Dress Code

At McKinley, we believe that children should learn in an environment appropriate to their age. We discourage dress that is more appropriate for older teenagers. Please help us to help your child grow and learn. All pupils are expected to keep their clothing neat, clean and in good repair. Shoes must be worn at all times. No open toed shoes or sandals allowed. Clothing and shoes must be appropriate so that students can participate in all class activities. Alcohol, drug and gang related clothing may not be worn. Shorts should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. ***HATS AND HEADCOVERING MAY NOT BE WORN IN SCHOOL OR IN CLASS EXCEPT FOR SPECIAL EVENTS.*** Clothing and accessories that are deemed by staff to be a disruption to the learning process are considered inappropriate. Students will be provided alternative clothing or the opportunity to have a family member bring appropriate attire. This includes but is not limited to; sagging pants, oversized shirts, medallions, large ear rings, etc.
