

# Meeker Middle School Uniform Policy

Our Meeker Uniform Policy is intentionally conservative to help students focus on learning. *Only the articles listed below may be worn for the Meeker Uniform.* **Students must arrive and leave each day in uniform.** Clothing may not be tight, oversized, or revealing. Clothing must be neat in appearance and worn appropriately. It is recommended that students keep a change of uniform clothes in their locker in case of emergency. All staff members are responsible for monitoring uniform compliance.

- A. TOPS:** A Meeker hoodie or traditional style polo shirt, having no more than 3 original buttons, must be worn at all times. Meeker clubs and organizations must order polo shirts or sweatshirts in Meeker colors.
1. Polos must be a solid color: **white, blue, or yellow**. Polos may not have logos or trim.
    - Polo shirts **must be tucked in**.
    - Only **plain white** crew neck t-shirts or tank tops are to be under the polo shirt and/or hoodie and **must be tucked in**. T-shirt sleeves may not hang lower than the polo sleeves.
  2. Meeker Middle School hoodies are available for purchase online at [www.c9sports.com/meeker](http://www.c9sports.com/meeker). **These items may not be altered or defaced**, including adding markings, colors, or cutting/ripping the item.
    - Personalized items, including but not limited to, 8<sup>th</sup> grade sweatshirts and club attire, may only be worn by the original purchaser.
    - Instead of a Meeker hoodie, a solid navy crew neck sweatshirt may be worn over a polo shirt.
- B. BOTTOMS:** These items may be cotton or corduroy. Absolutely no denim or fabrics containing spandex. “Skinny” pants are not acceptable at school for boys or girls.
1. Solid navy blue and tan (khaki) are the only acceptable colors: **no brown, white, or gray**.
  2. Items **must be plain in style** with no added adornments. Cargo pants are acceptable.
  3. Slacks and shorts must be securely worn at the waist at all times.
    - **NO SAGGING**
    - A zip tie may be required if pants are not secure.
  4. Length of bottoms must be at least to the knee. Cut-offs are not appropriate for school.
- C. OUTERWEAR:** In addition to bags, backpacks, and purses; outerwear items such as jackets, coats, fleece, sweaters, non-uniform sweatshirts, vests, gloves, scarves, hats, and sunglasses must be kept in lockers during school hours.
1. Outerwear may be worn during lunch, but only outside the building.
  2. Shoes are required at all times.
    - Flip-flops and slippers are not acceptable at any time.
    - No shoes with wheels.
- D. ACCESSORIES:**
1. Hats, hoods and other head coverings are not to be worn inside the building.  
*Please remove such items upon entry.* (Religious/cultural items excluded.)
  2. Sweatbands, bandanas and chains are not allowed. Lanyards may only be worn around the neck.
