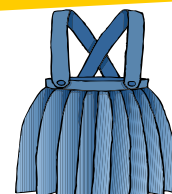


What TOPS Are Okay?

What BOTTOMS are Okay?



- ▶ **SOLID COLORS ONLY!**
- ▶ Pants or Capris
- ▶ Walking Shorts
- ▶ Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers must be
Within 3 inches of the knee
- ▶ Tights Uniform Colors
- ▶ NO LEGGINGS
- ▶ NO JEANS or BLACK PANTS
- ▶ NO CARGO PANTS
- ▶ NO SAGGING

What Happens When You DO NOT Wear a Uniform to School?

Discipline Guidelines

1st Infraction

- Call parents and a letter sent home

2nd Infraction

- Call parents to either bring in uniform or parents pick up student

3rd Infraction

- Parent Conference and possible Student transfer to another school
