

The Day Reporting School is a **Neutral Zone** and the following dress code has been adopted.

Day Reporting School Dress Code SY 2008-2009

Solid* White or Gray Tee or Polo Shirt or Top/Blouse *with sleeves*

Solid Gray, Black or White Sweatshirt or Sweater (optional)

Solid Blue, Black or Khaki Denim Jeans or Blue/Black/Khaki Dress Slacks

Solid White or Black Socks

Solid White, Black or Brown Shoes or Boots to include the same solid color shoelaces, soles, logos and stitching for a solid color appearance

Solid White, Black or Brown Belts

****Shirts will be tucked with belt lines showing at all times.**

***Solid means all one color—no contrasting colors of stitching, logos, soles or decorations of any kind.**

The following clothing/items are considered inappropriate for school:

Sunglasses, hats, headbands, do-rags, bandanas, sweat pants or spandex clothing, capris, shorts, skirts or dresses, slippers, tank tops, colored hair beads or ribbons, colored belts or shoelaces, military style or large metal buckles, belt ends hanging down longer than four inches, shirts with logos or graphics, sharp jewelry, clothing with holes or tears, sagging pants below the hip bone, dragging pants below the top of the shoe, exposed midriff, cleavage, or undergarments, any clothing or accessory suggesting gang affiliation. Coats and jackets will be checked-in with security at the door. **The Principal will make the final decision on what is acceptable.**
