

Sherman Elementary School Uniform Dress Standards

Why Uniform Dress Standards?

Sherman Uniform Dress Standards reflect pride and unity, and demonstrate that school is a place to study and learn. Our Sherman Uniform Dress Standards support student safety and promote a focused, orderly school climate. They have been chosen to be consistent, affordable, and available. Standards are also designed to provide a “business-like” atmosphere, to help students develop the lifelong habit of dressing appropriately for the workplace and *not to keep up with current fashion trends*.

Keep in mind that school is a student’s workplace; just as adults at work have dress standards, so do Sherman students.

What do the Sherman Uniform Dress Standards require?

Sherman students are required to wear uniform clothing every day (*except for free dress days that may be scheduled throughout the year as a reward for good behavior as determined by the School Centered Decision Making Team (SCDM) and ASB*).

All clothing must be neat in appearance, in good repair, and worn appropriately. The fit and/or style of the clothing should not be tight, revealing, or oversized.

Only the clothing listed below may be worn for as part of the Sherman Uniform Dress Standards.

SHIRTS

- A. **Colors:** white, navy blue, or yellow (Shirts worn under the polo must also be plain, solid white, navy blue, or yellow shirts.)
- B. **Polo style ONLY**, traditional/classic, not form fitted, 2-5 buttons
- C. No logos are acceptable on polos or sweatshirts - *except Sherman Elementary School logo tops purchased from school.*
- D. Polos **must** be worn under sweatshirts.
- E. All tops must be worn **right side out**.

PANTS, SHORTS, SKIRTS, SKORTS, AND CAPRIS

- A. **Colors:** navy blue, khaki (tan), or solid blue jeans (no faded or bleached jeans.)
- B. **Fabric:** Fabric should be cotton twill, corduroy, or traditional blue jean
- C. Must be fitted, plain in style, and **hemmed neatly**. No adornments (patches, holes, stripes, or any other decorations) and **no sagging**.
- D. The length of short skirts, skorts, and shorts must be within three (3) inches of the knee.

SWEATSHIRTS

- A. **Colors:** white, navy blue, or yellow
- B. No logos, except Sherman Wear
- C. Crew/round neck or hooded sweatshirts

SHOES

- A. Shoes should be appropriate for all school activities – no flip-flops, no shoes without a back strap or slipper-like footwear allowed.
- B. No bare feet are allowed.
- C. Tennis shoes are always a great option.
