Not Acceptable

Logos, undershirts worn as outerwear, body piercings, (earrings ok) NO DOO RAGS , denim, sweats, tank tops , sleeveless tops, sagging, dragging, baggies, open toe shoes, flip flops, open heels, stacked heels, roller shoes, oversized earrings or necklaces, chains, oversized buckles, hair dye, make-up or distracting nail polish.

Tips

Belts must be worn in belt loops. Shirts must be tucked in or cannot hang below the pocket line of pants. One size larger is allowed for growth is acceptable.



If students do not wear proper uniforms the teacher will call parents. A printed note will be sent home. Repeated non-compliance will require a problem solving conference with the principal.
