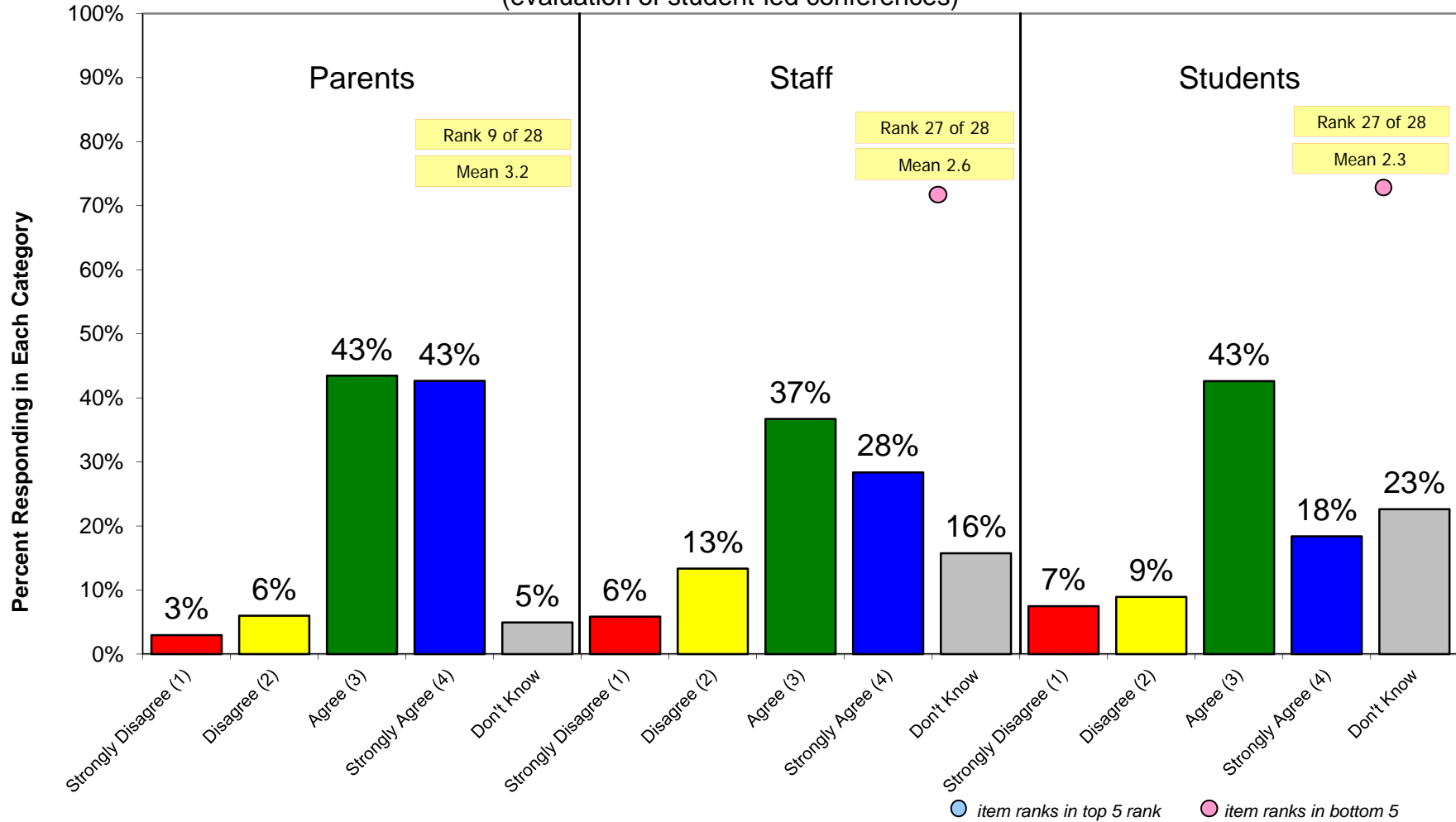


# 1. ...were student-led conference worthwhile?

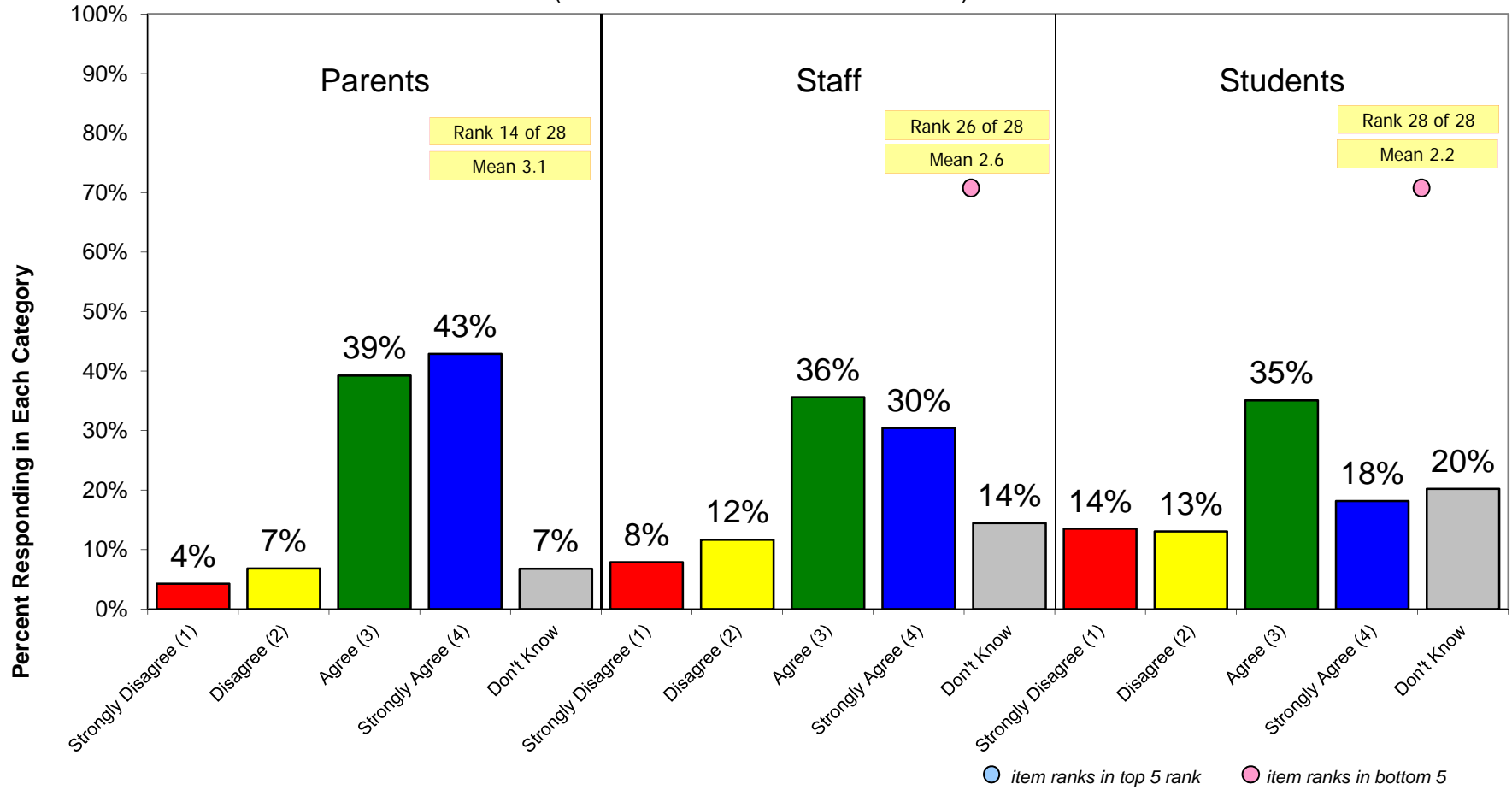
(evaluation of student-led conferences)



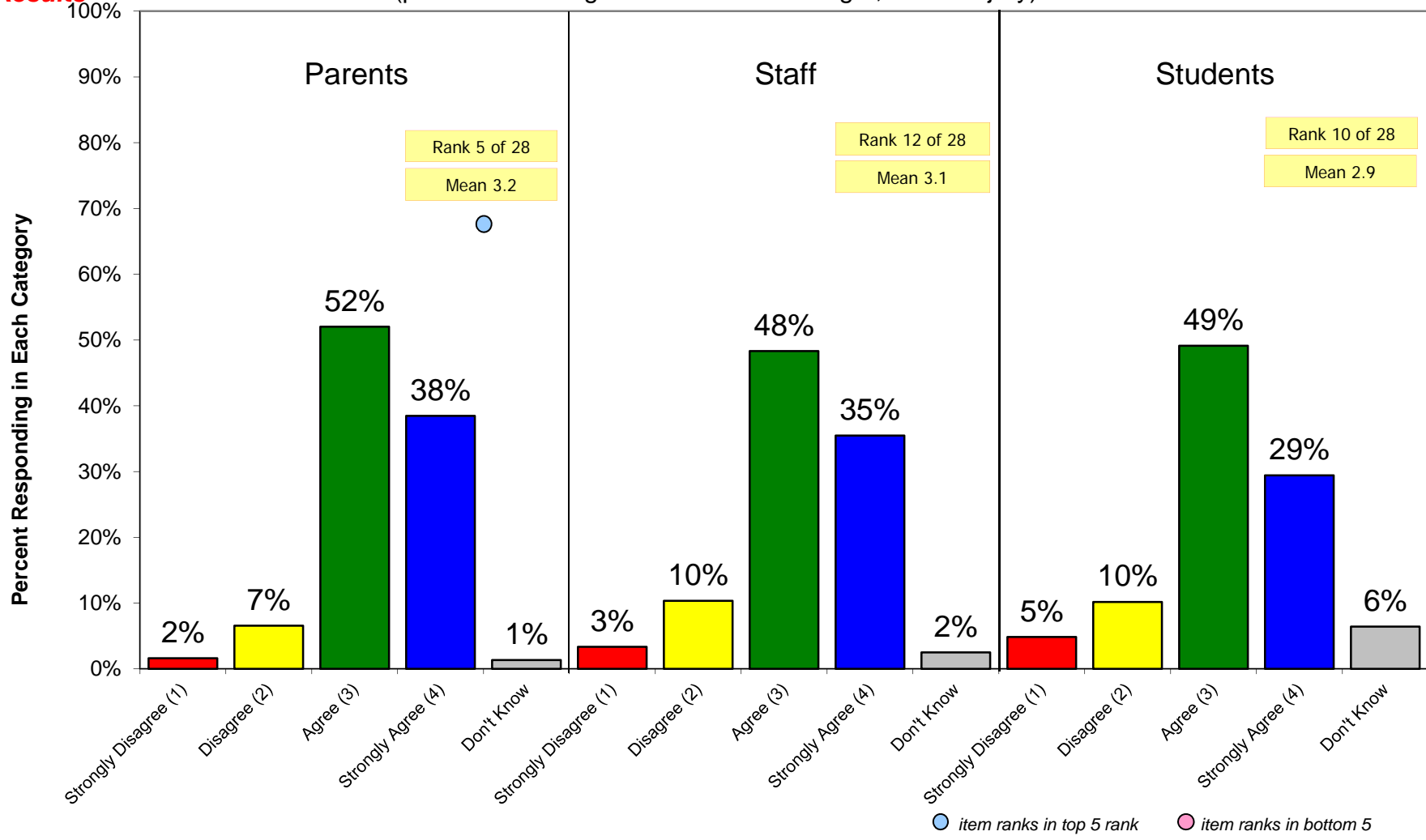
## 2. ...Should there be student-led conferences again next?

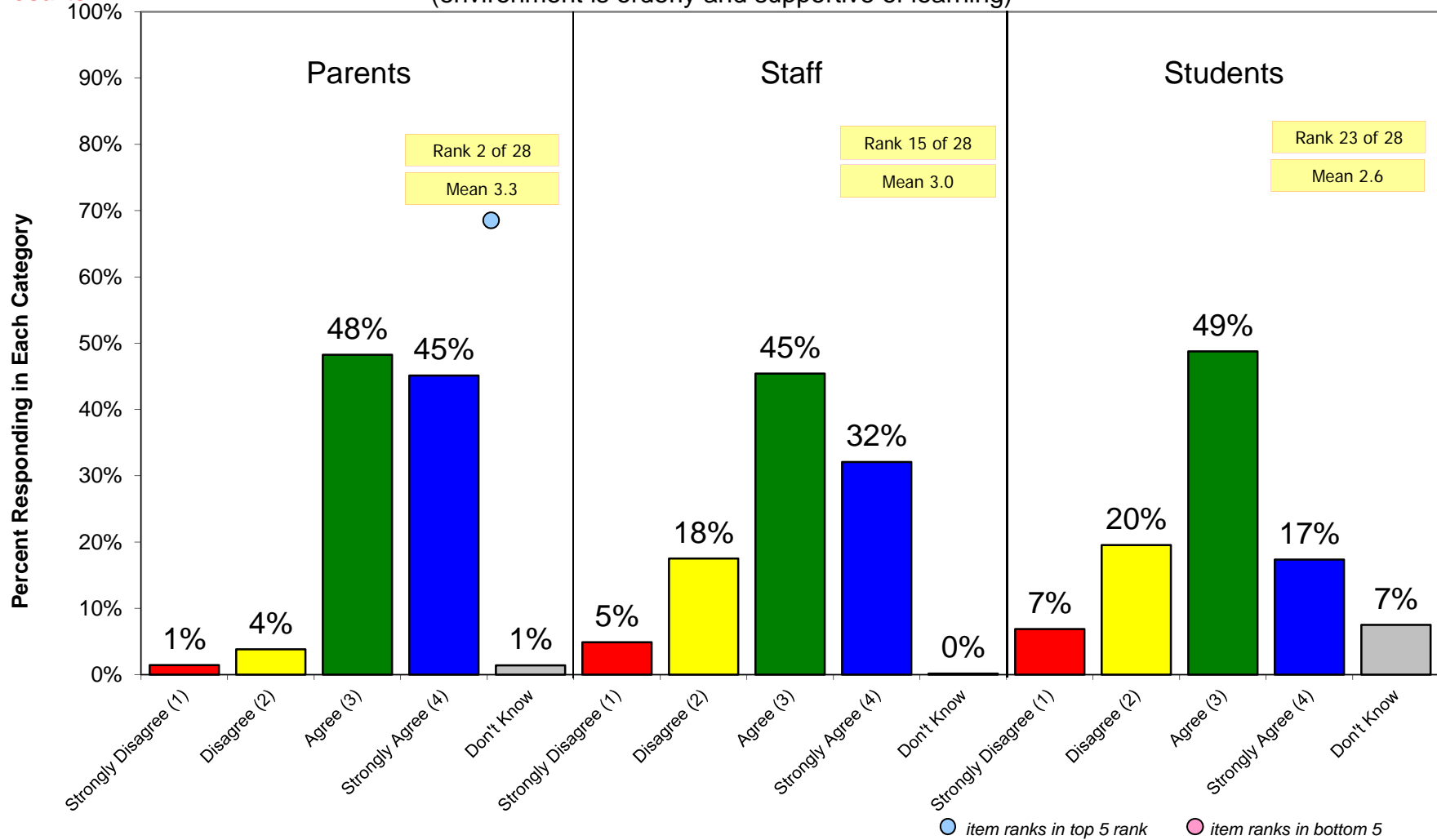
(future of student-led conferences)



### 3. ...at school, I feel safe and secure. (perceived feeling of freedom from danger, risk or injury)

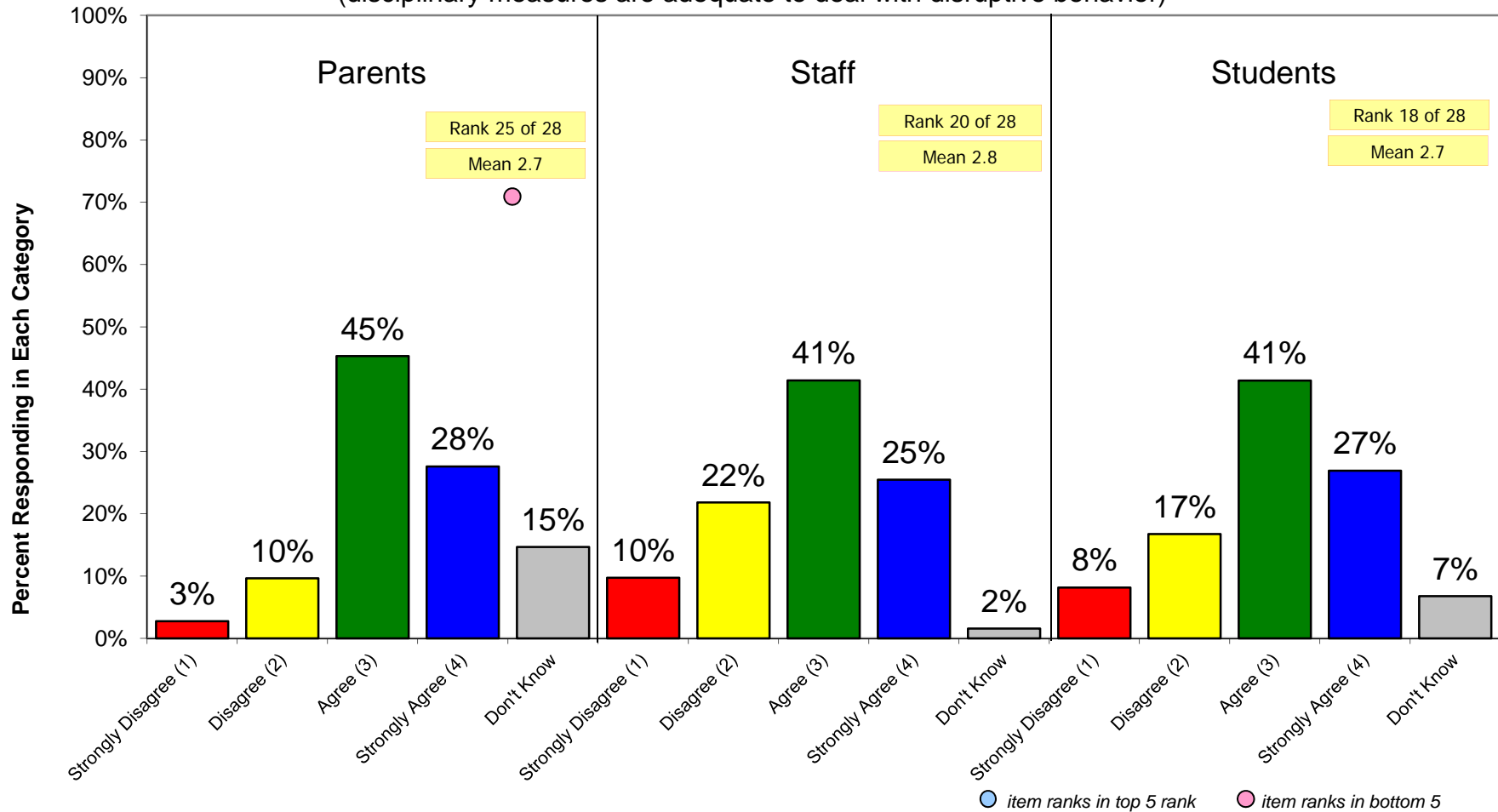


### 4. ...school building is kept clean. (environment is orderly and supportive of learning)



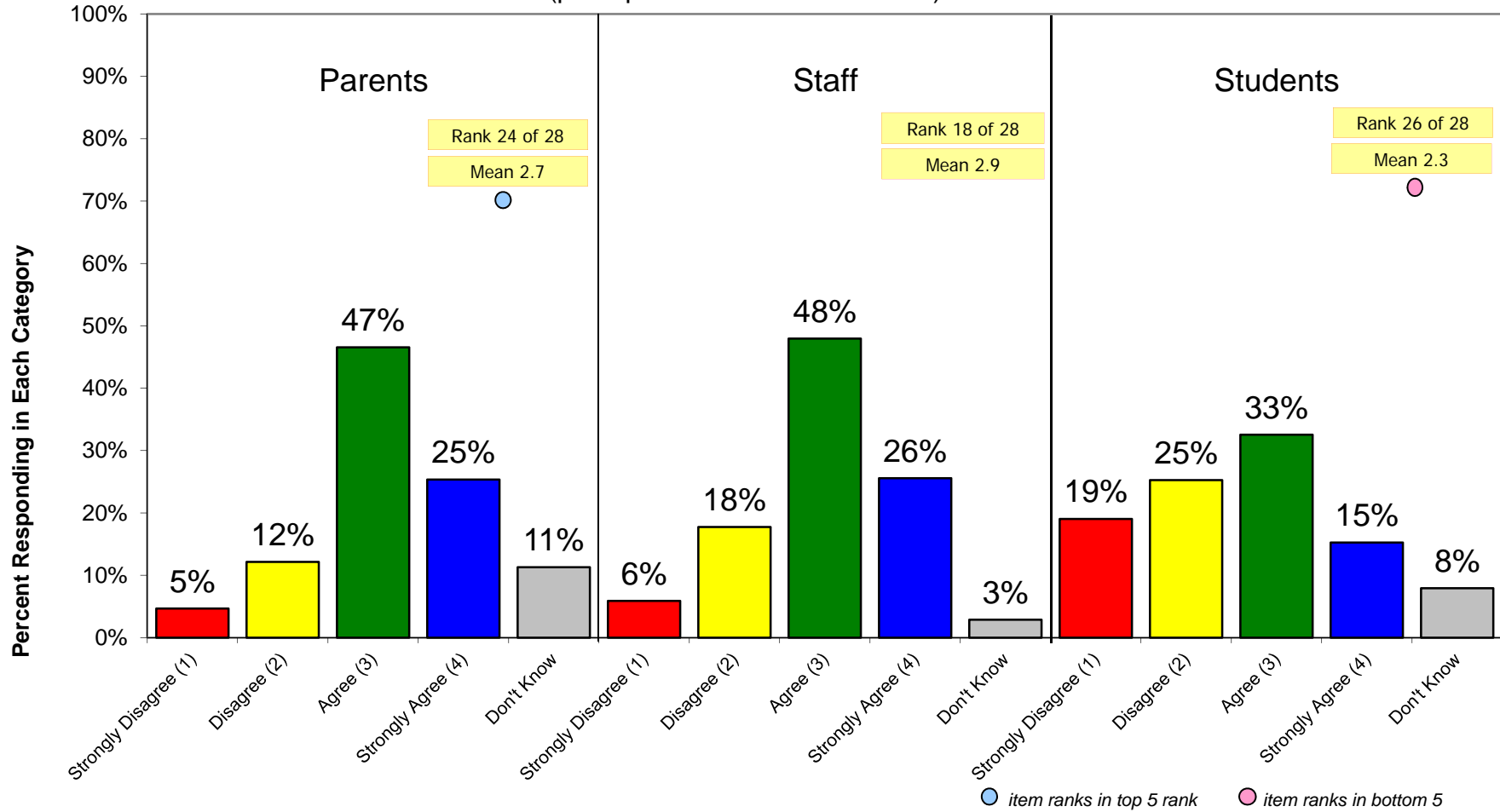
## 5. ...staff do a good job dealing with students who misbehave.

(disciplinary measures are adequate to deal with disruptive behavior)



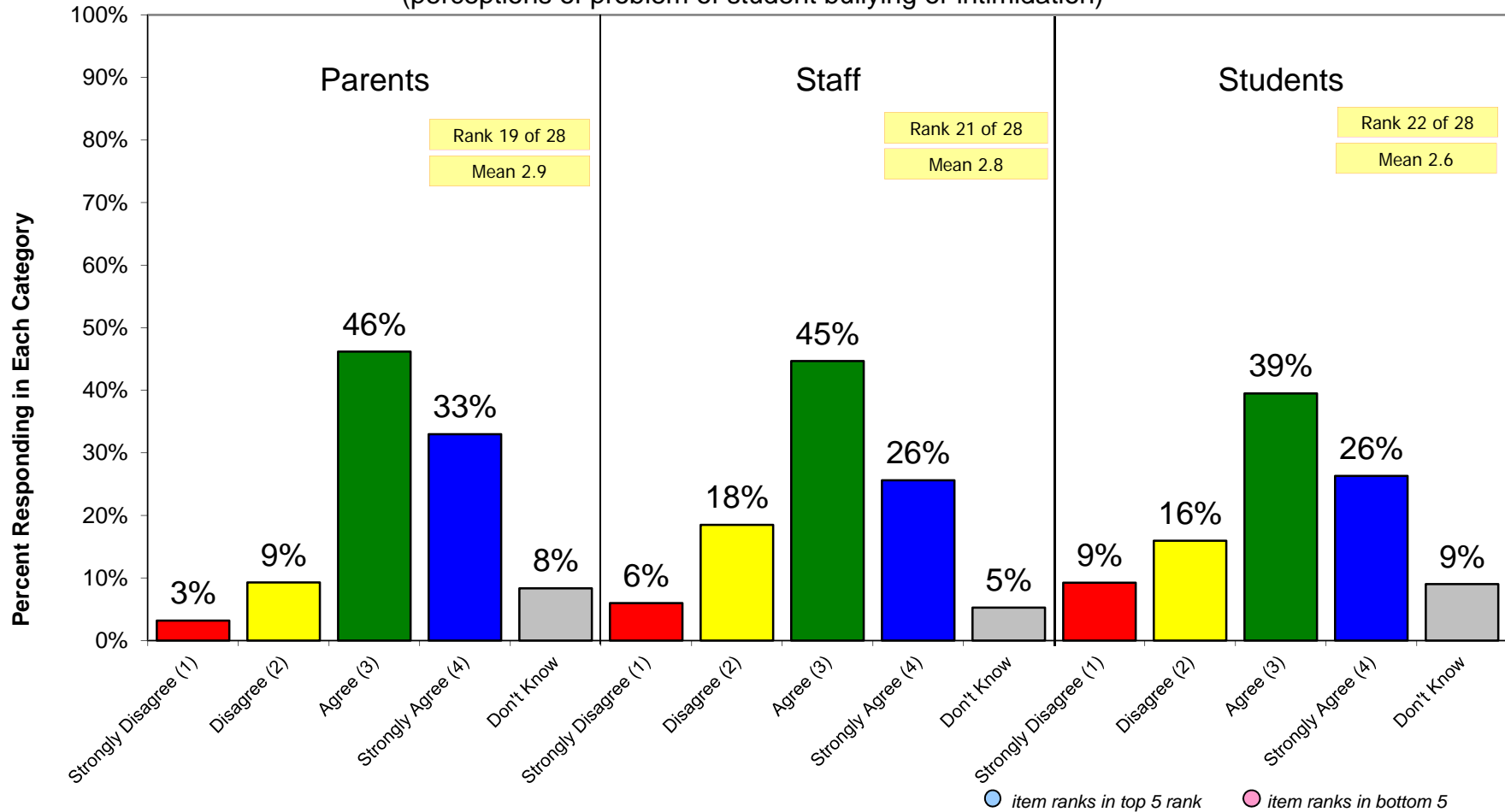
## 6. ...violence and student fighting are not major problems.

(perceptions of student violence)

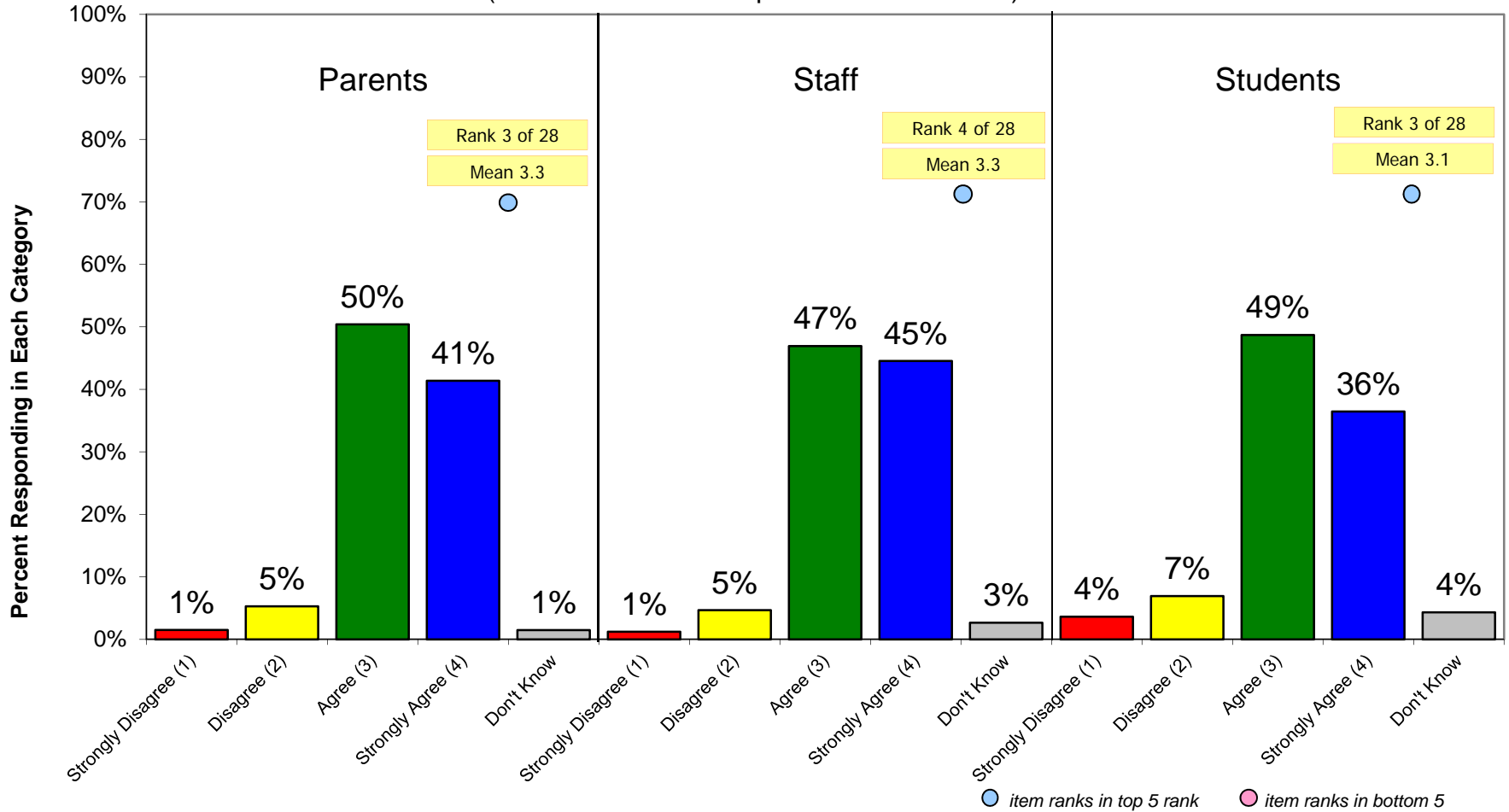


## 7. ...staff do a good job dealing with students who bully, harass, or intimidate other students.

(perceptions of problem of student bullying or intimidation)

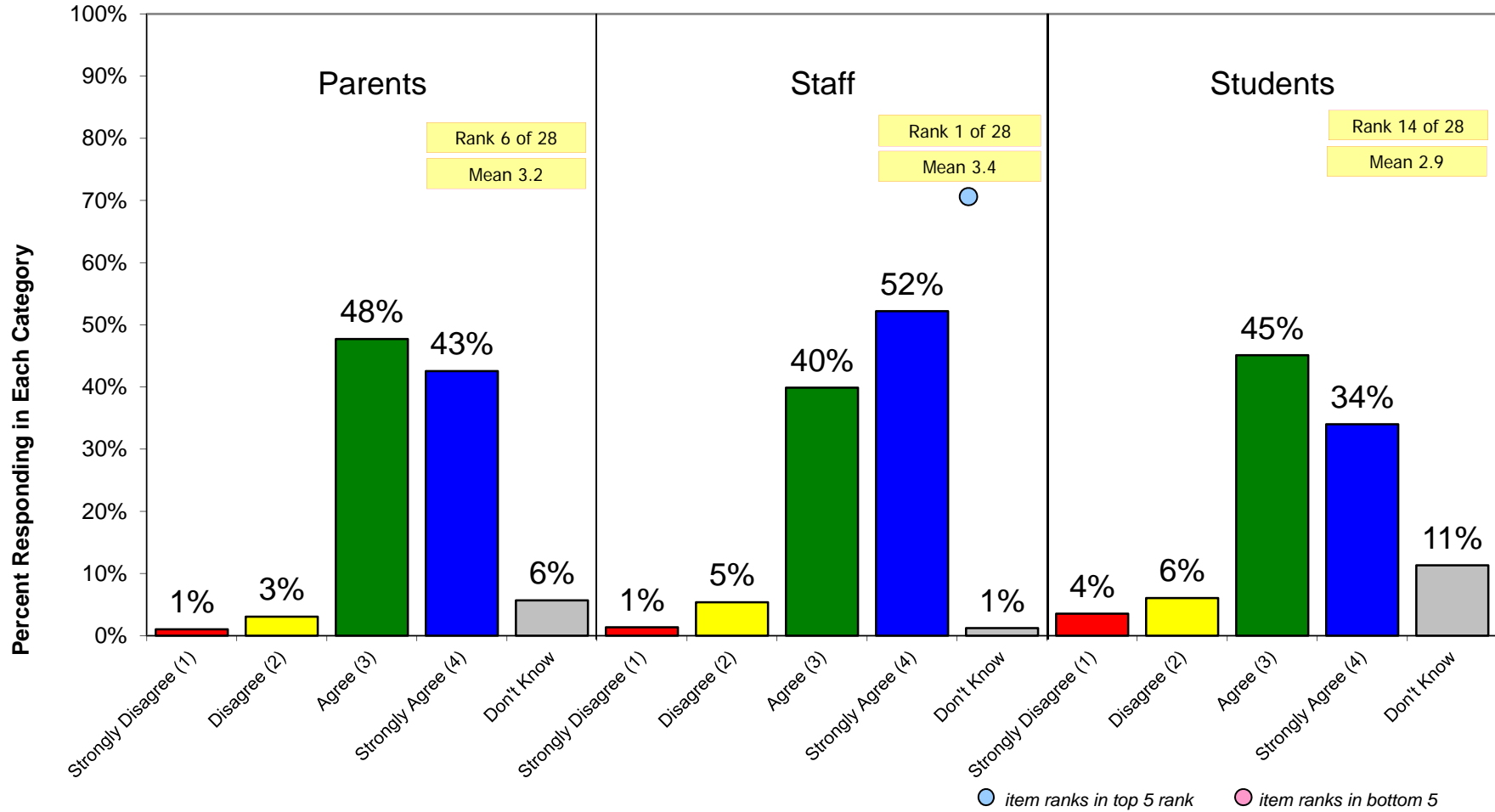


## 8. ...questions about school work, students/parents know who to turn to for help. (staff is accessible to parents and students)

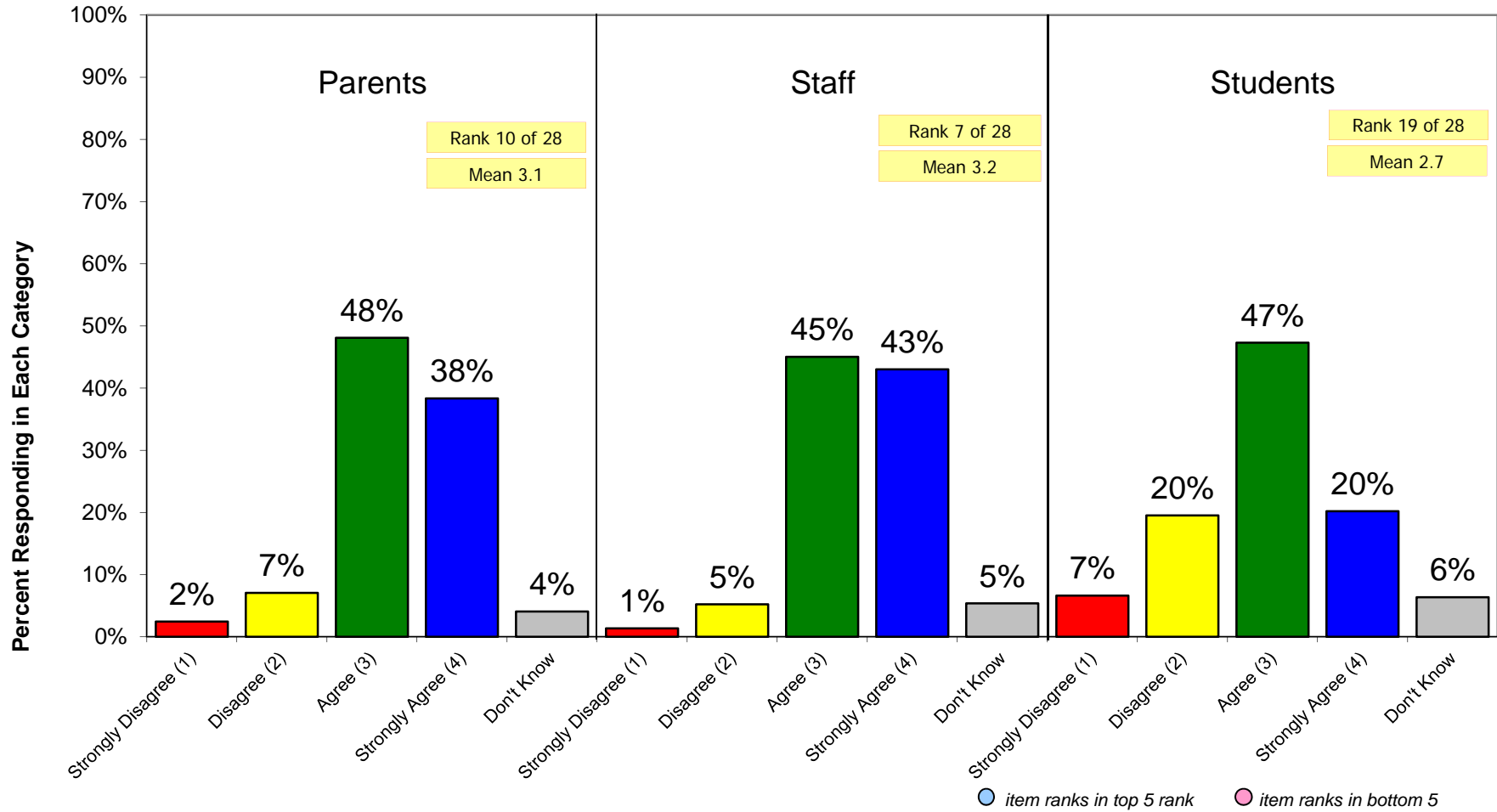


## 9. ...staff at my school take pride in the school.

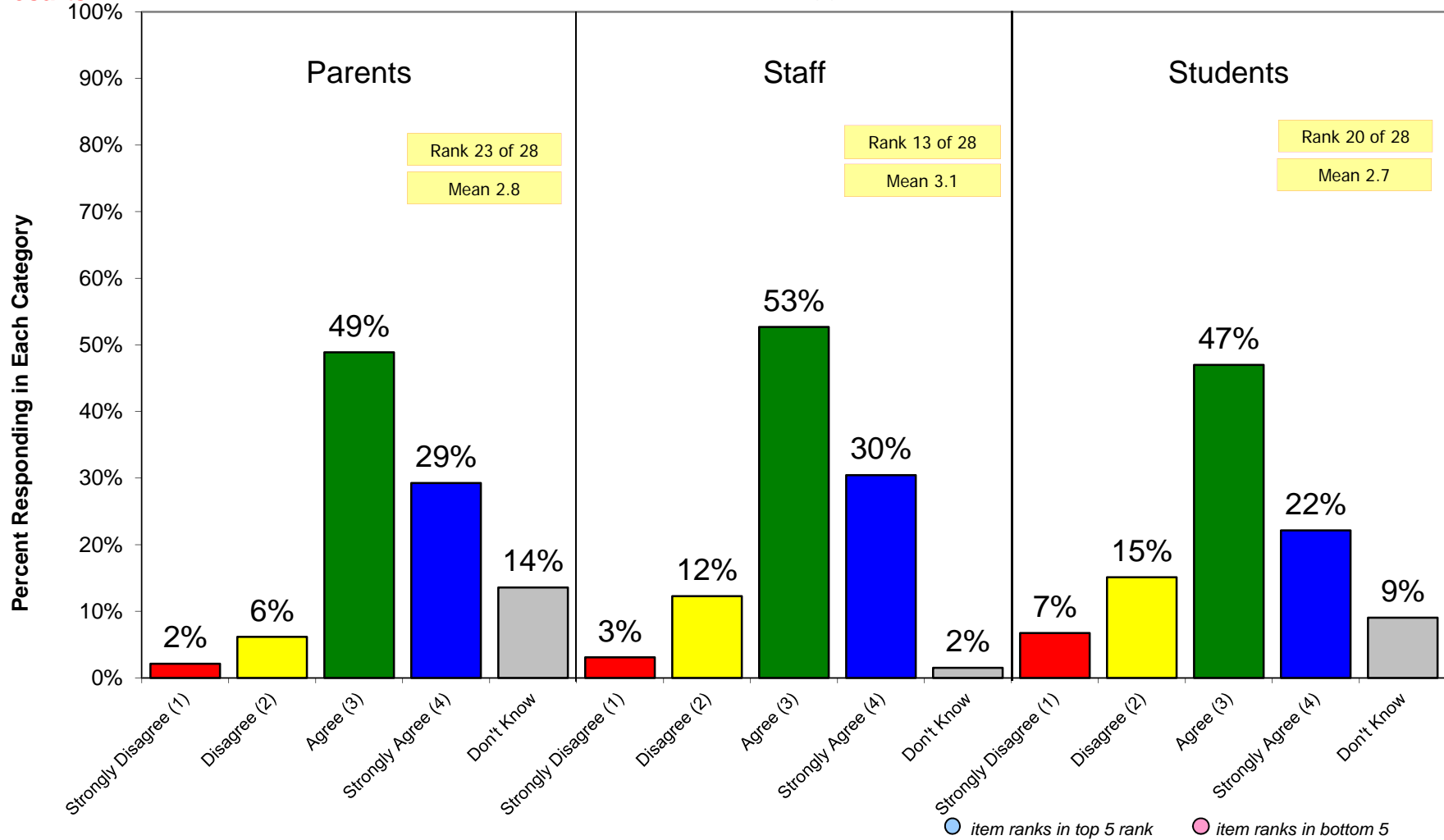
(school pride and spirit are visible)



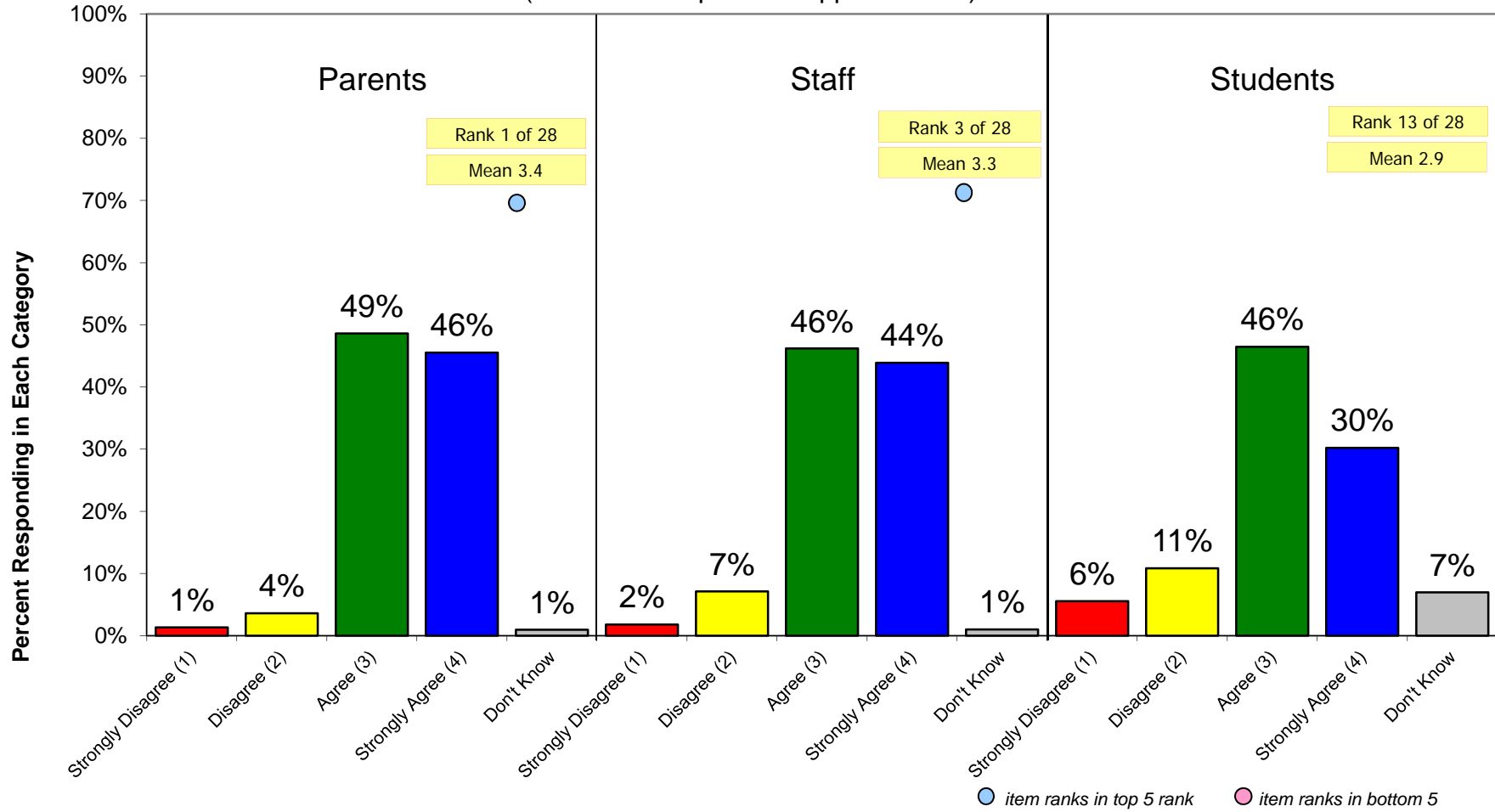
## 10. ...if questions or concern, staff respond quickly. (communicate in a timely response)



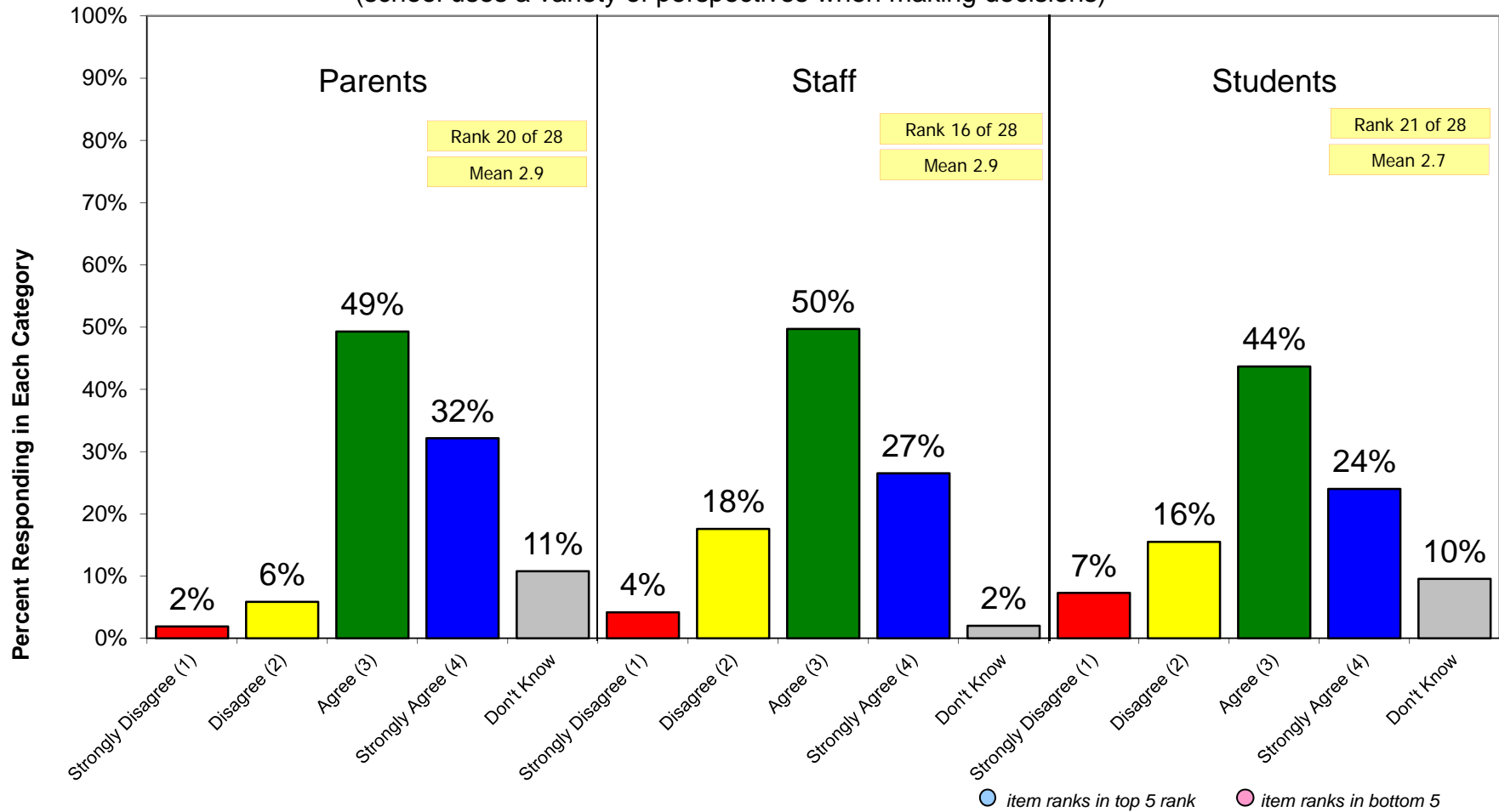
# 11. ...teachers seem to listen to suggestions. (the staff seem open and receptive to suggestions and new ideas)



## 12. ...staff are friendly and welcoming. (the staff are open and approachable)

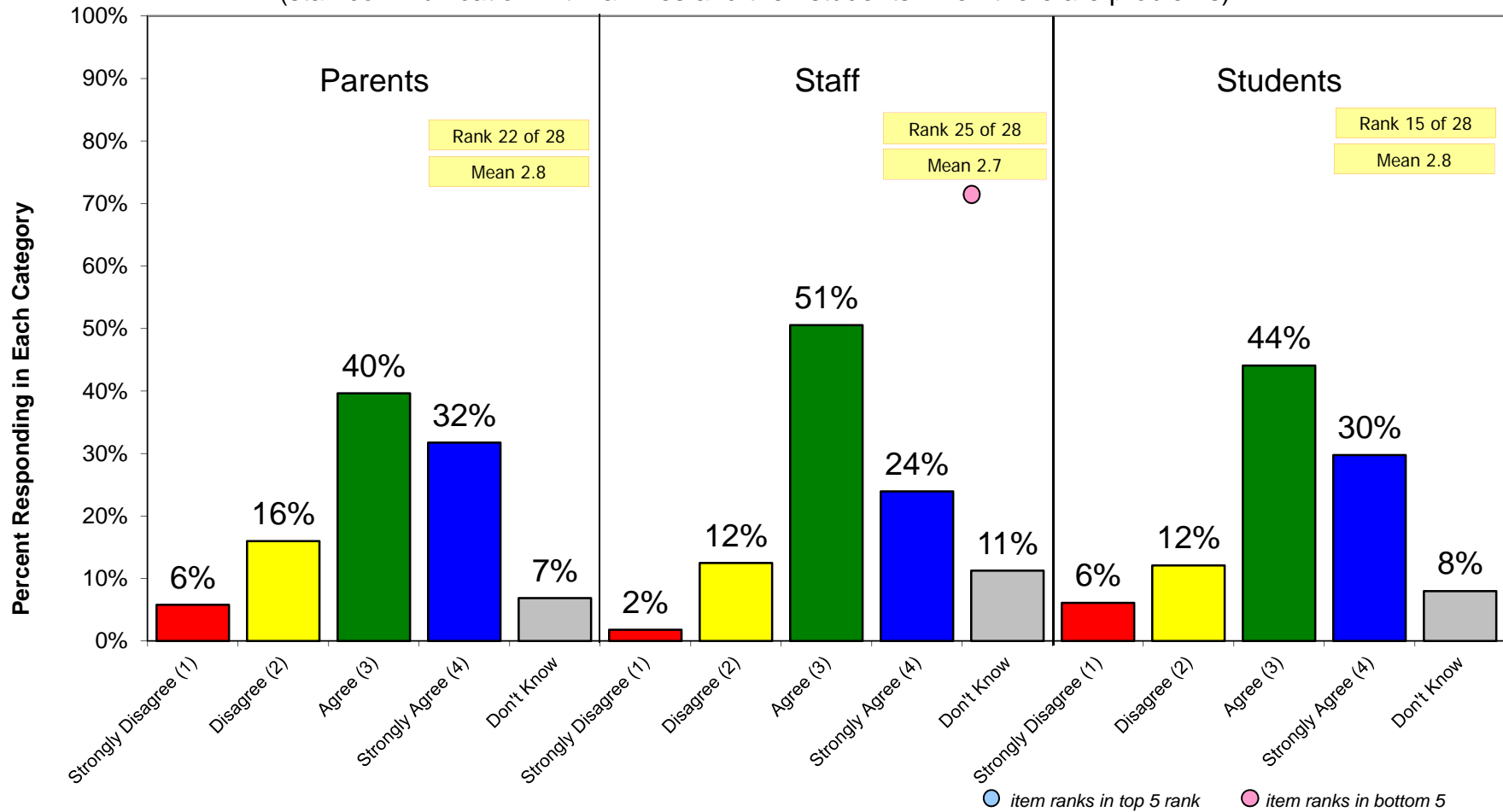


# 13. ...staff take the time to listen to thoughts and feelings. (school uses a variety of perspectives when making decisions)

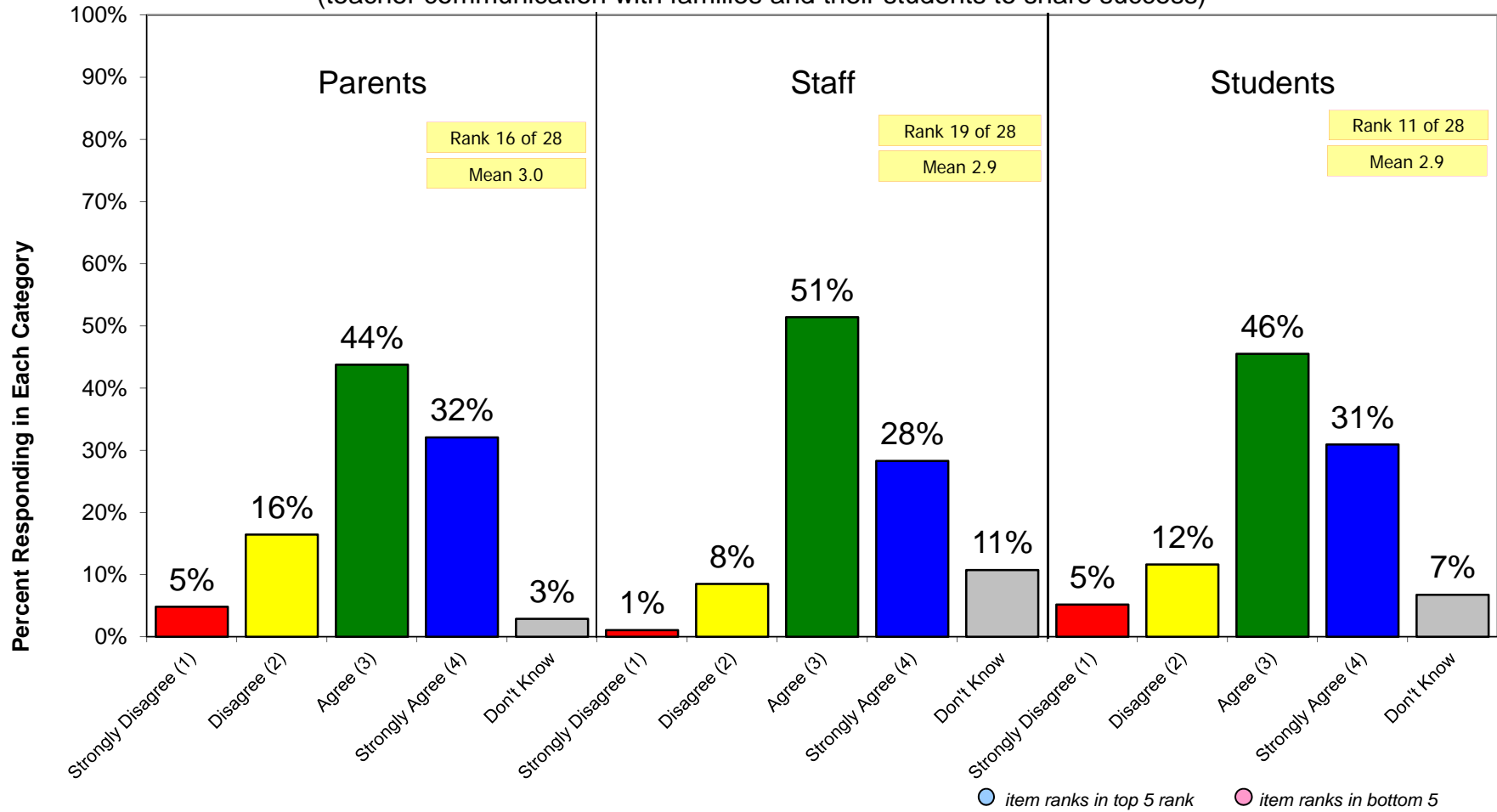


# 14. ...school let families know right away if there is a problem.

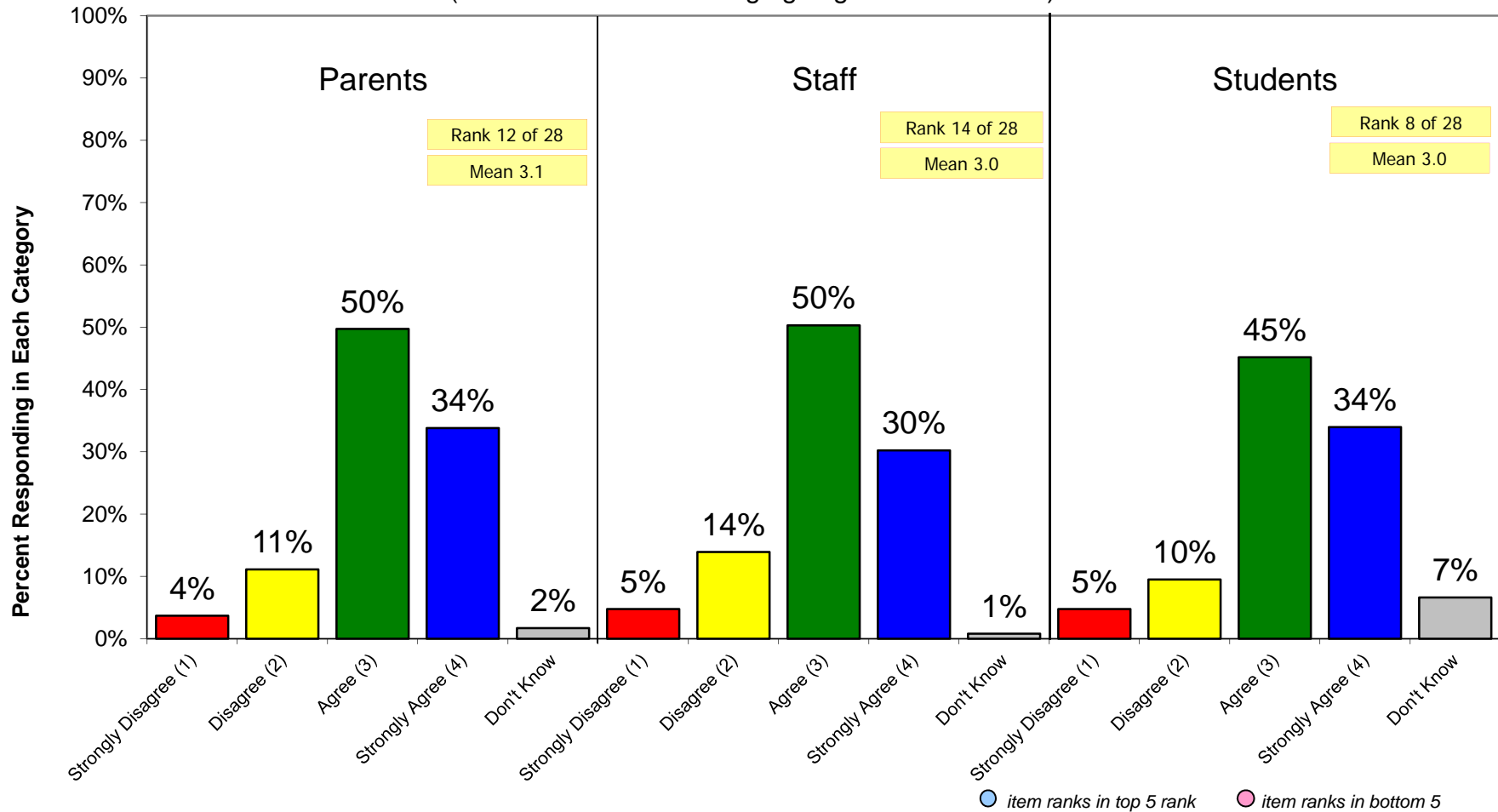
(staff communication with families and their students when there are problems)



# 15. ...staff tells students when I'm doing well academically. (teacher communication with families and their students to share success)

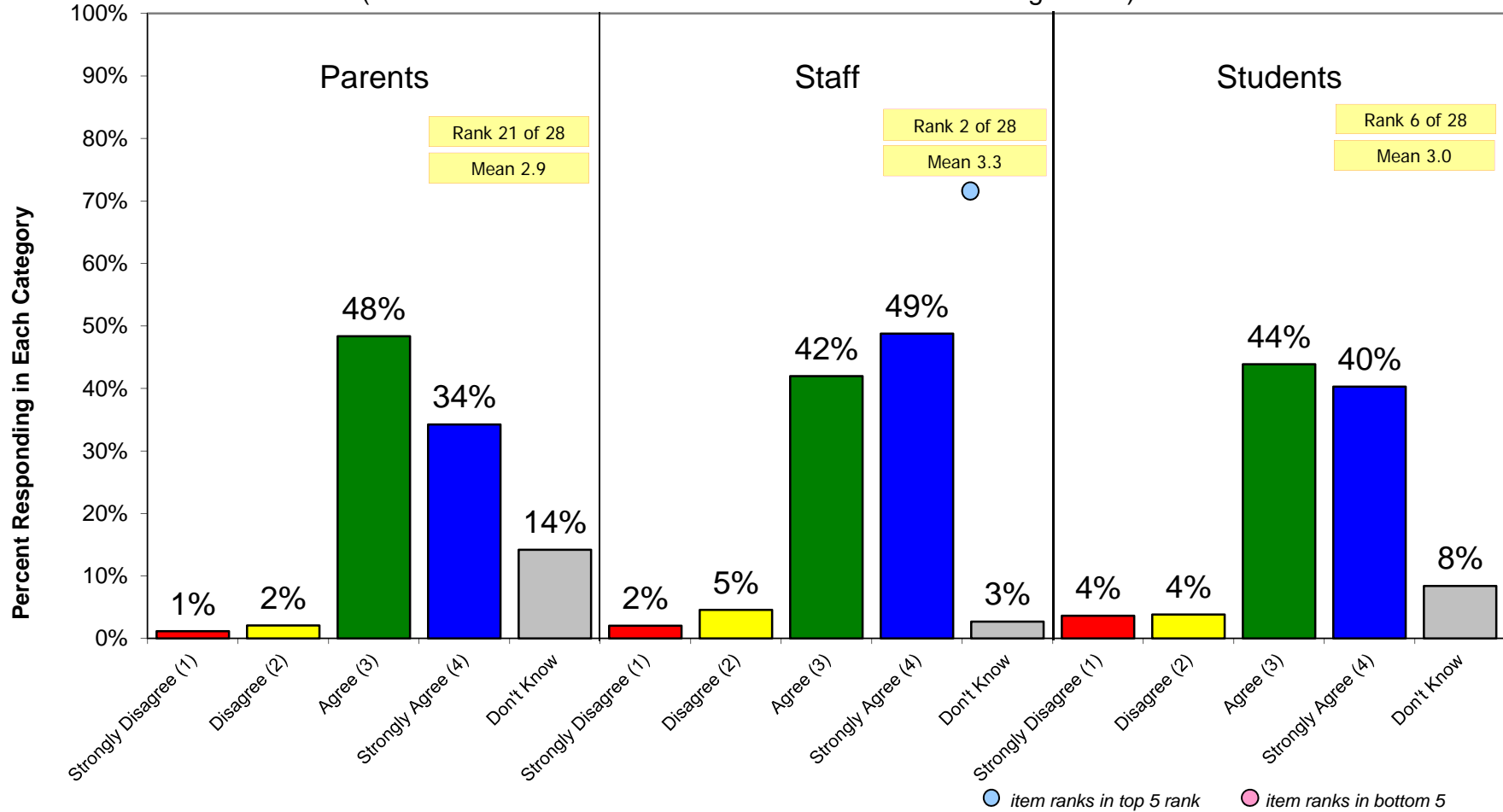


## 16. ...students/parents are informed about activities and events going on in the school. (well informed about things going on in the school)

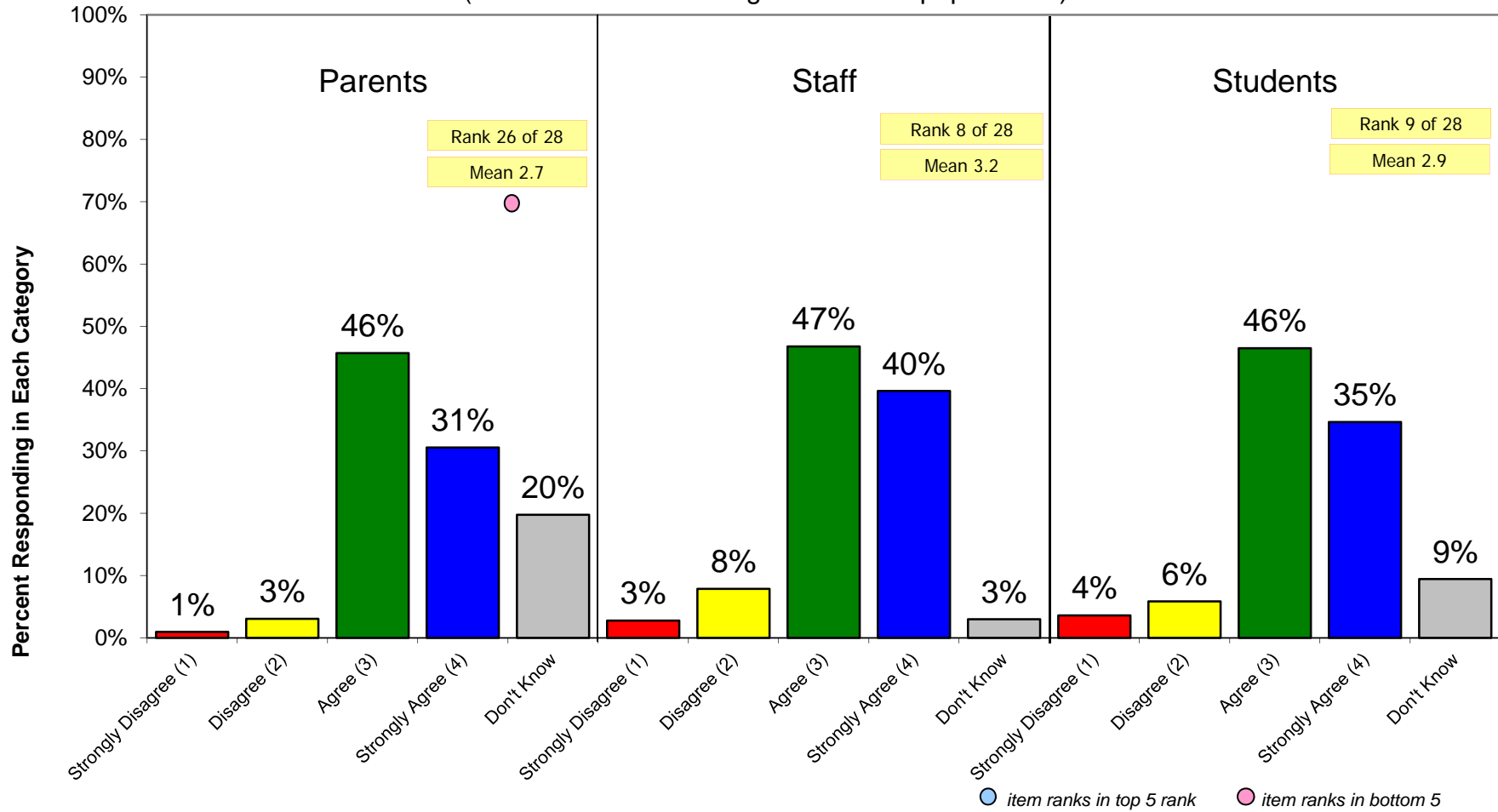


# 17. ...support getting along with people of different cultures and ethnic groups.

(staff embrace all families of different cultures and backgrounds)

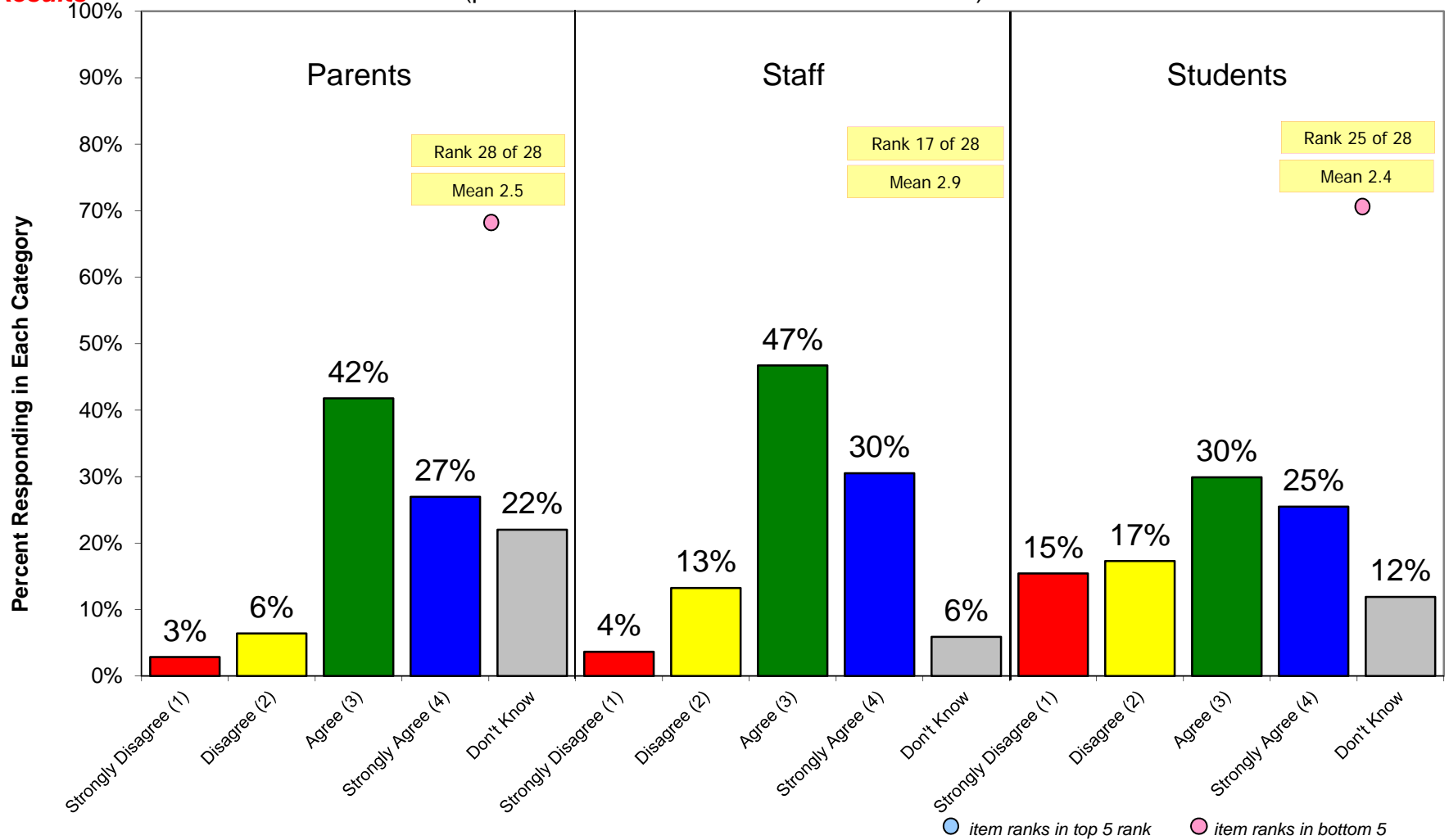


**18. ...are good at working with a diverse group of students.**  
(staff effective in working with diverse populations)

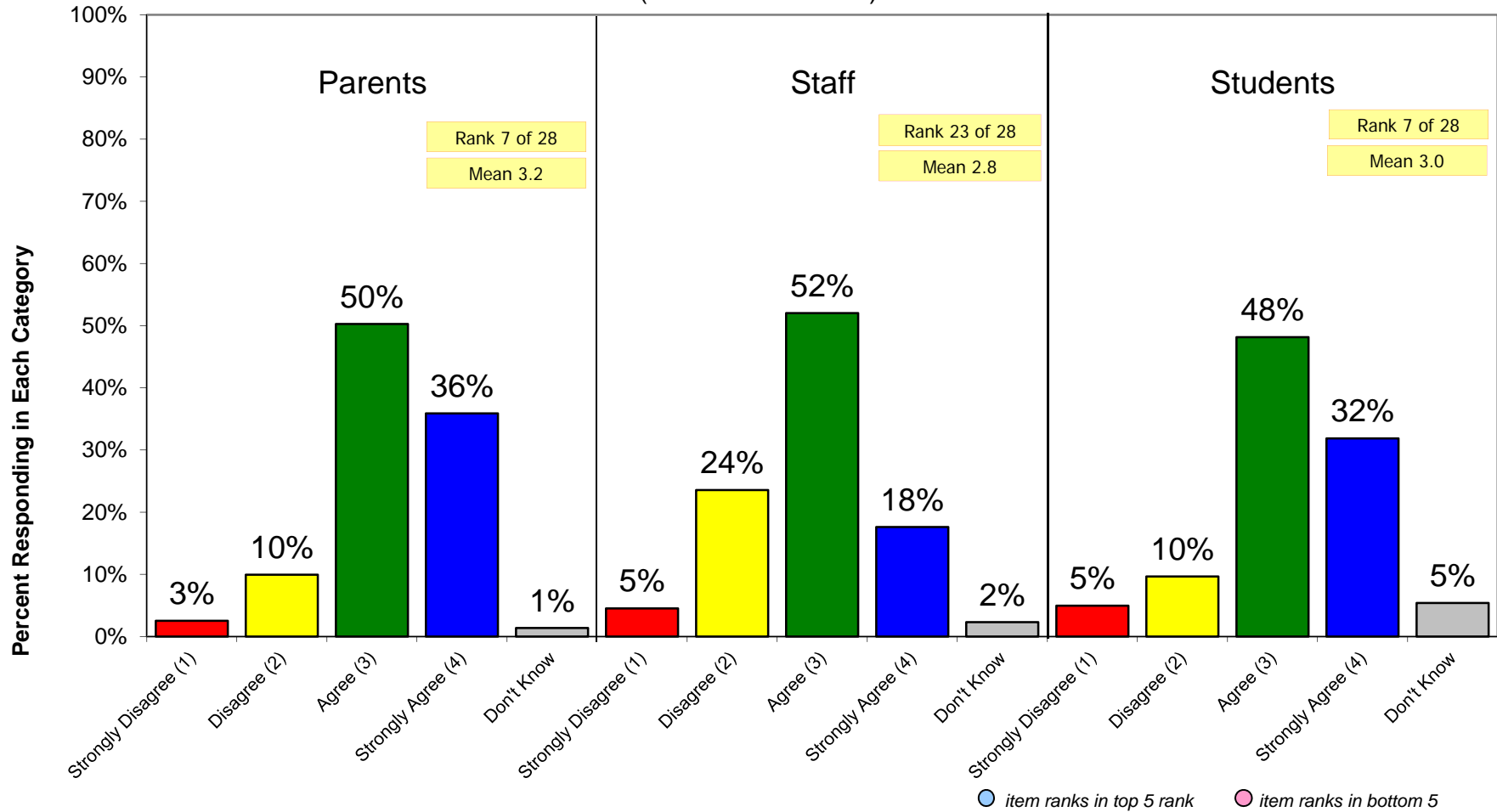


# 19. ...racism is not a problem at my school.

(percieved racism in the school environment)

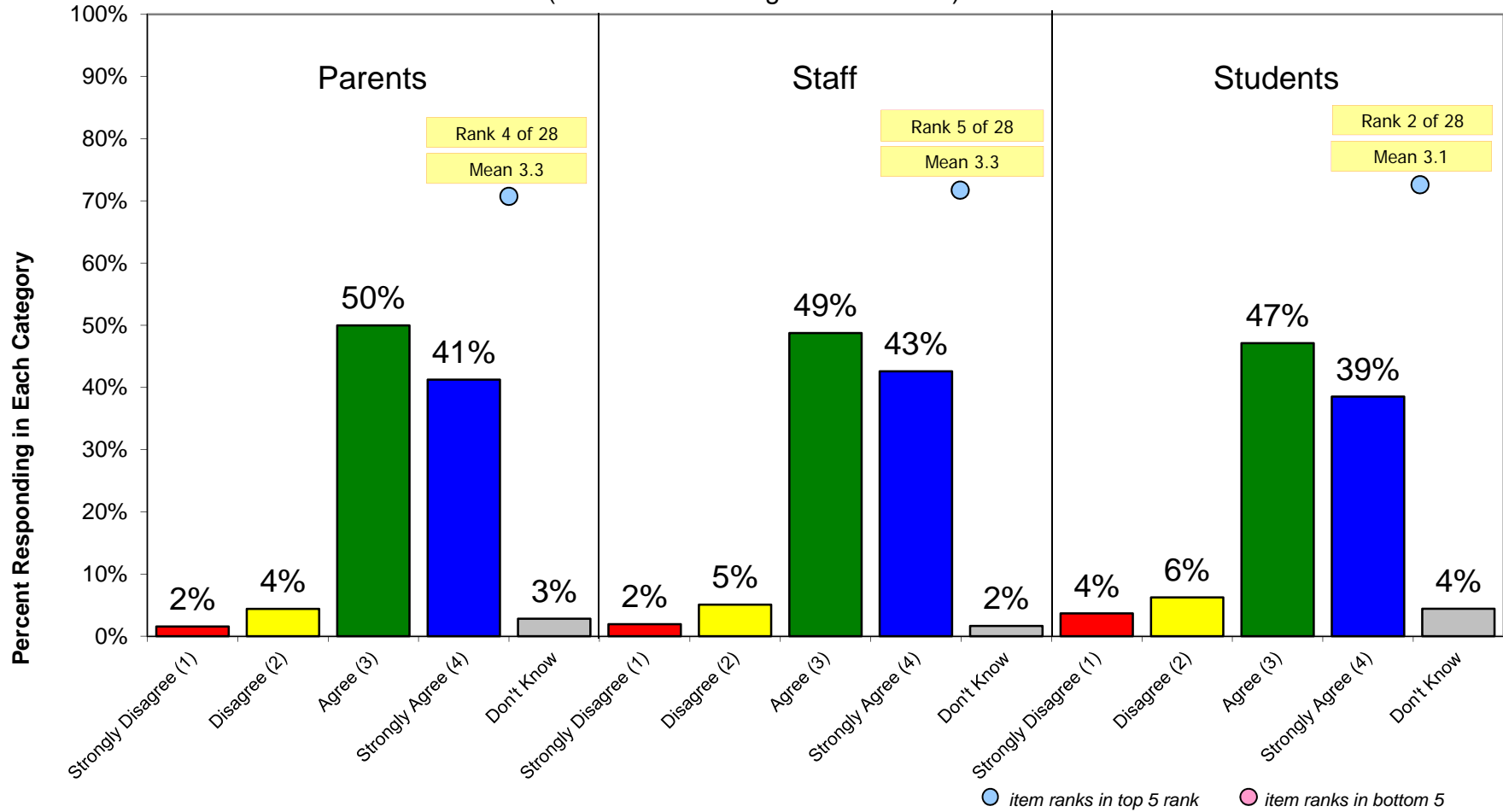


## 20. ...students motivated to learn and do challenging work. (motivation to learn)

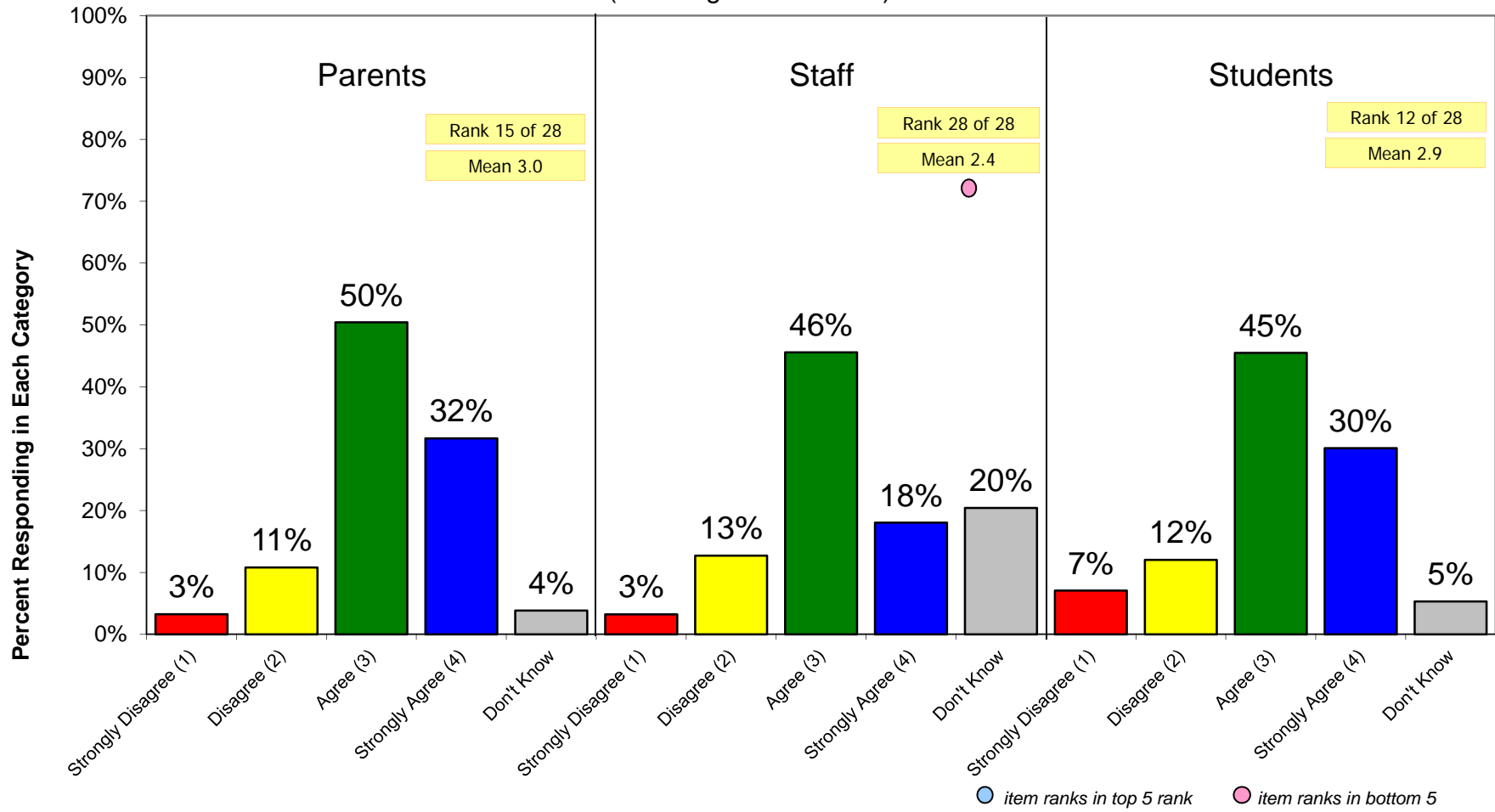


## 21. ...teachers encourage learning. (commitment to a good education)

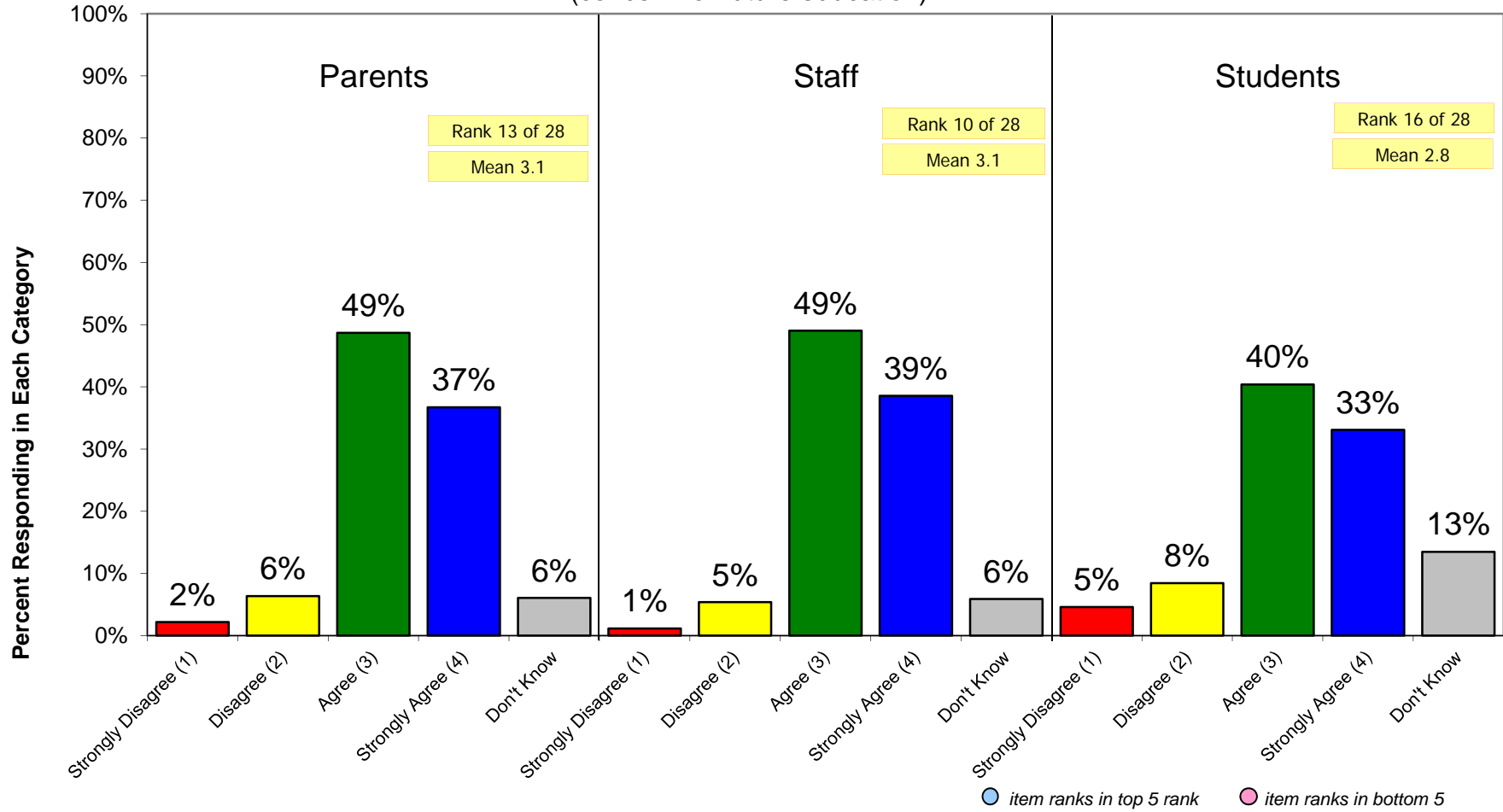


## 22. ...homework teachers give helps students to learn. (meaningful homework)



## 23. ...teachers are interested in students future education.

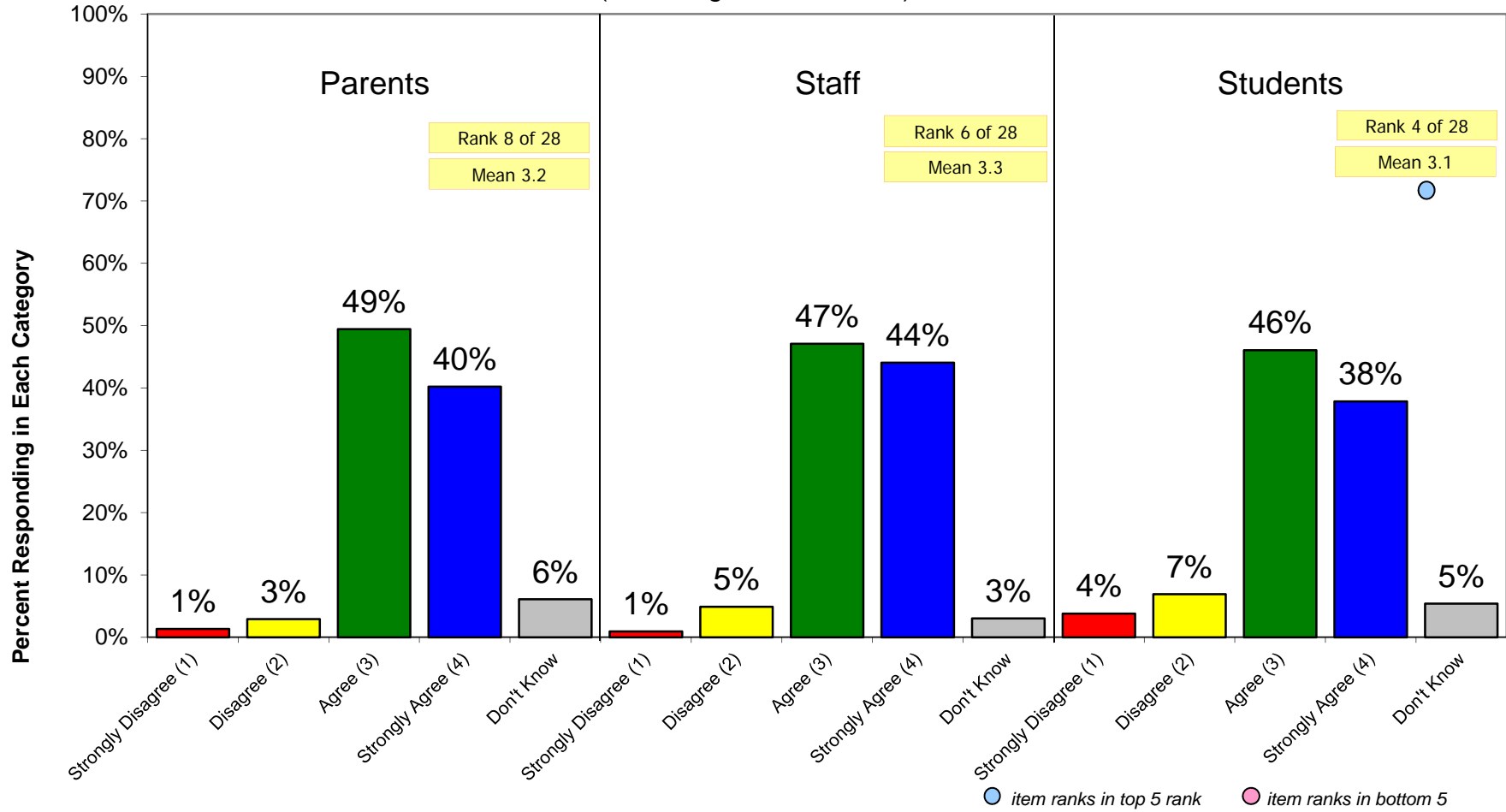

# 24. ...staff know a lot about the subjects they teach.

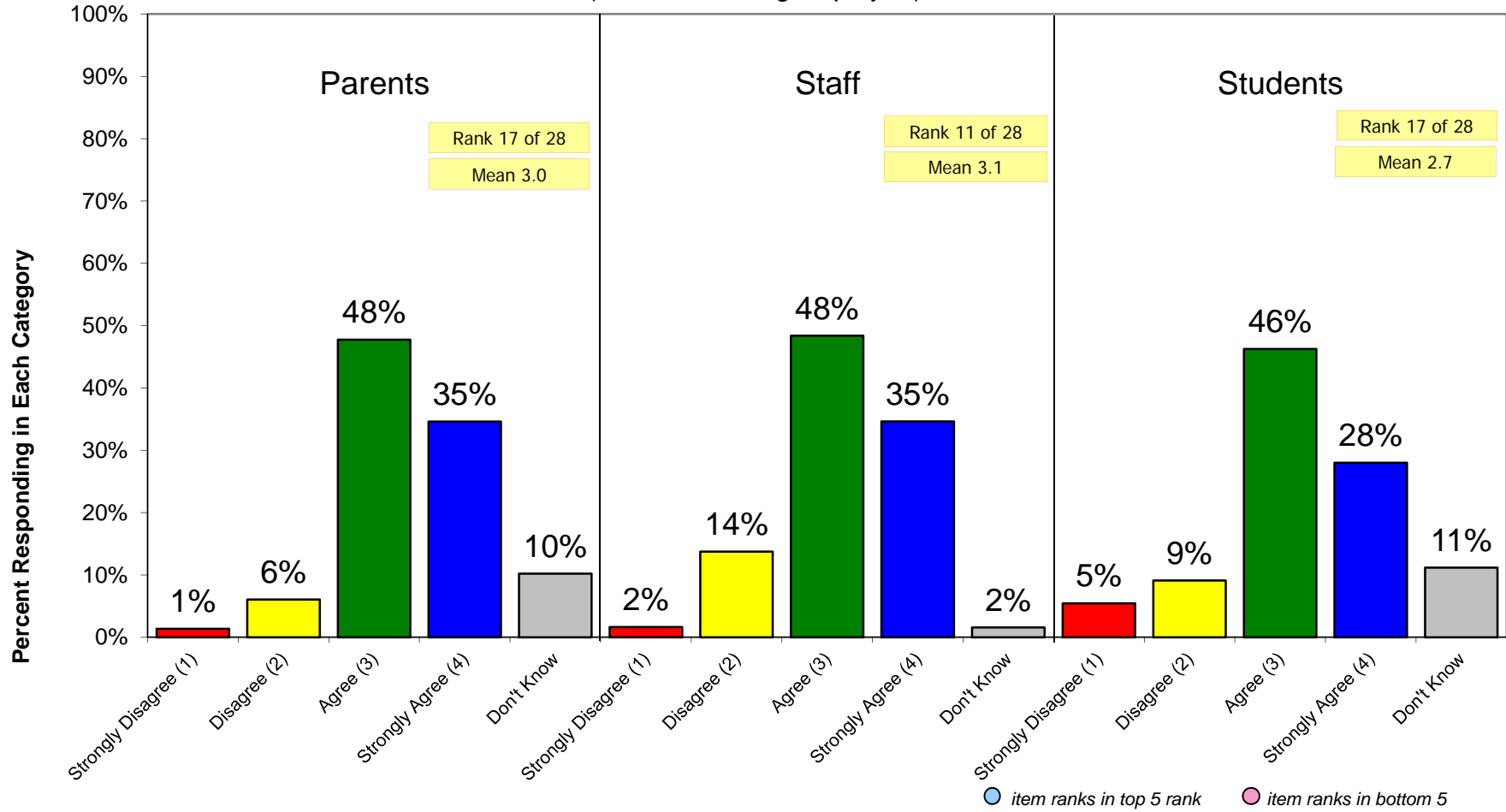

## 25. ...at school, student work is on display.

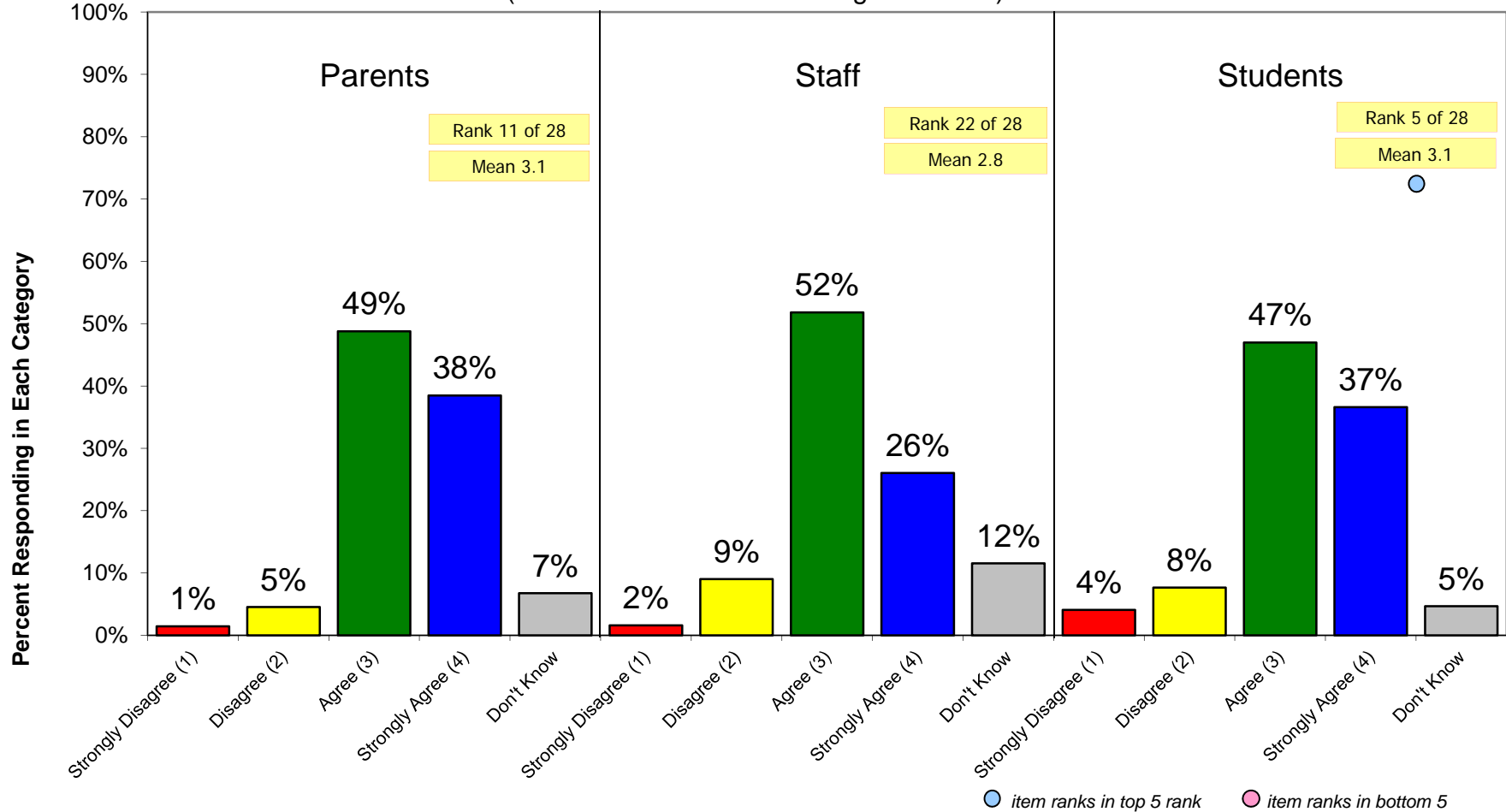
(student learning displayed)

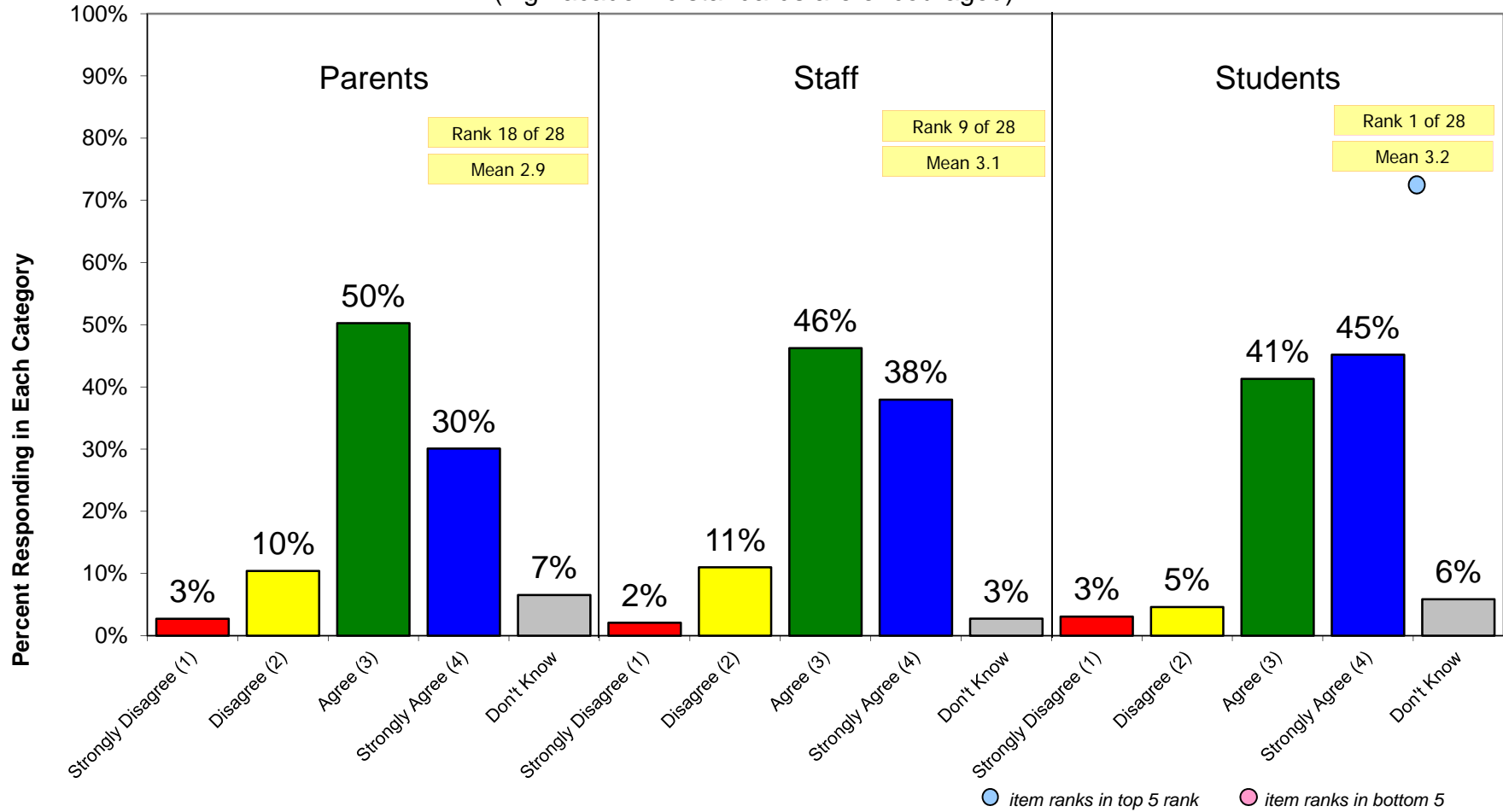

# 27. ...expect students to meet high standards.

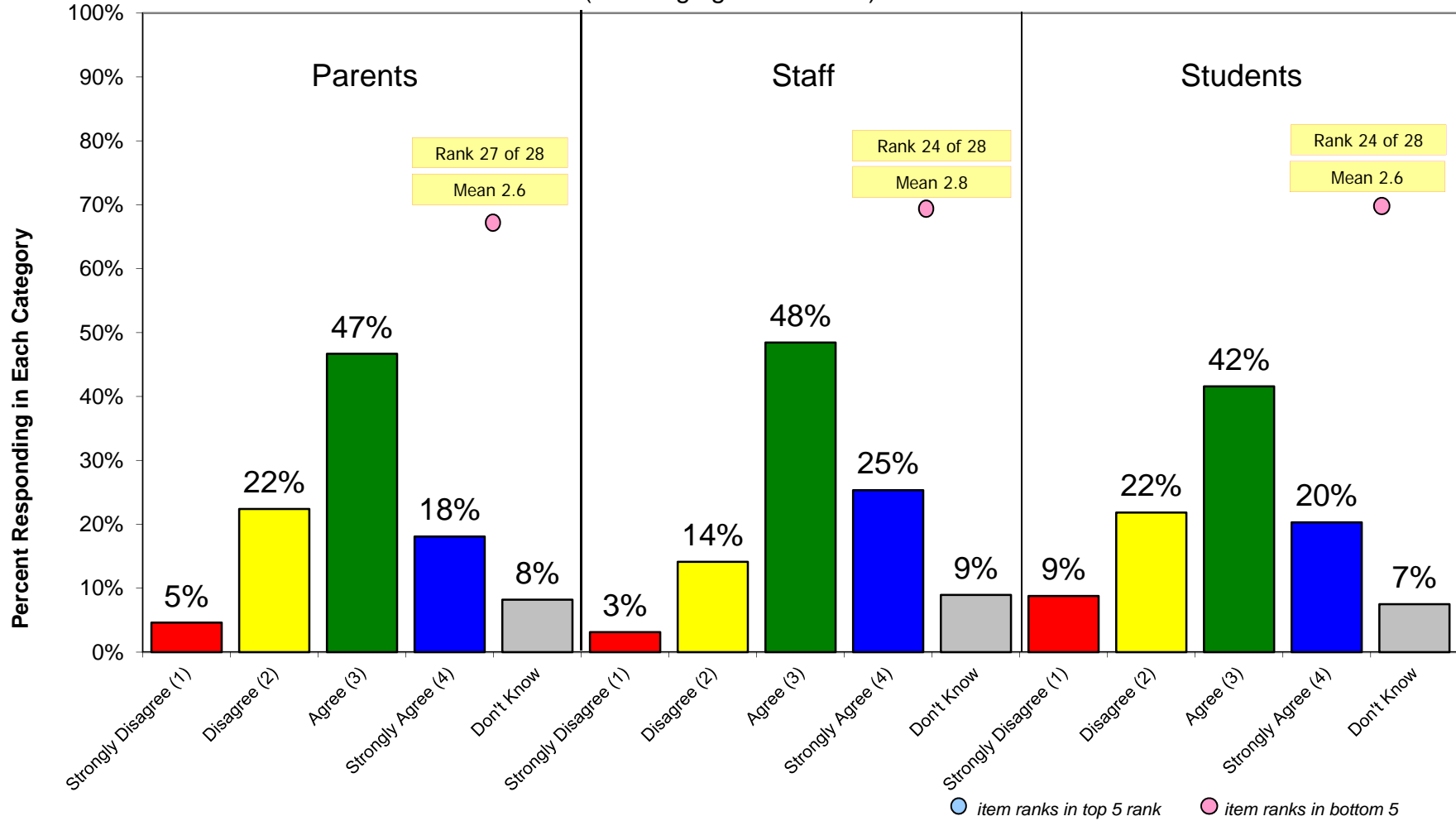
