

SAT-I Results for 2010

SAT: Overview

College admissions officers and scholarship committees use these results as one of several indicators of student's ability to do college level work. The SAT is administered seven times a year. Scores for each section are reported on a scale ranging from 200 to 800. The previous SAT-I had been criticized for not measuring what students learn in class. To align the SAT-I more closely to curriculum and skills required for success in college, the SAT-I took effect for the class of 9th graders who entered college in the fall of 2008 with normal progression.

The SAT-I Verbal Exam has been modified to the SAT-I Critical Reading Exam. This test no longer includes analogies. Instead, short reading sections are added to existing long reading passages.

A new section called the SAT-I Writing Exam has been added. This section contains multiple-choice grammar questions as well as a written essay.

The SAT-I Math Exam has been expanded to include topics from third-year college preparatory math.

(Disaggregated by Race/Ethnicity)

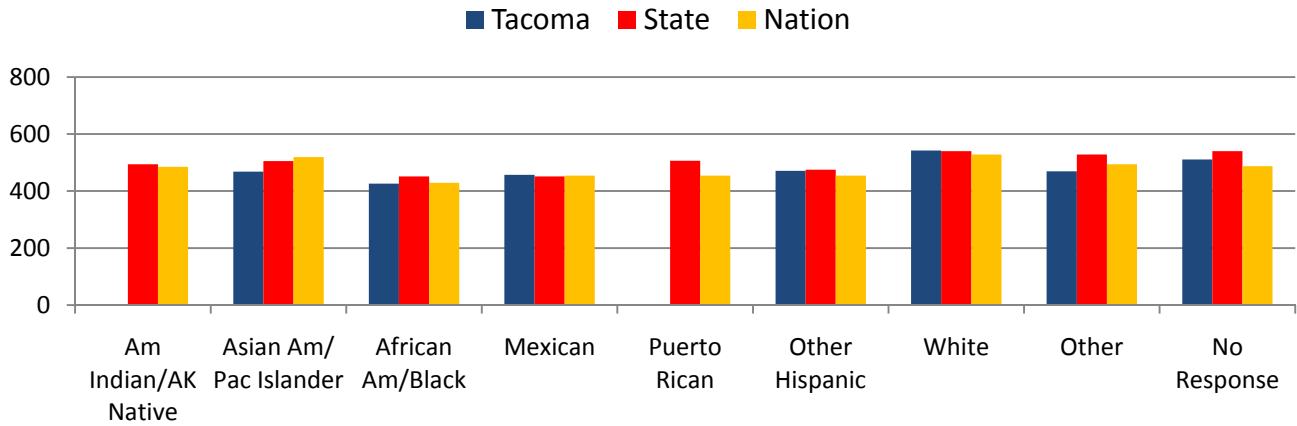

(Disaggregated by Race/Ethnicity)

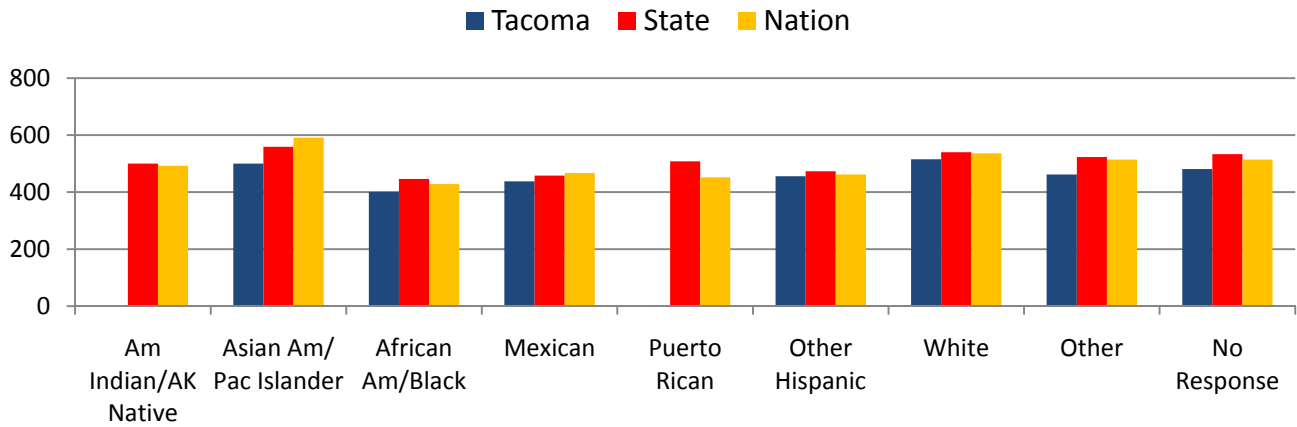


Chart 3:

(Disaggregated by Race/Ethnicity)

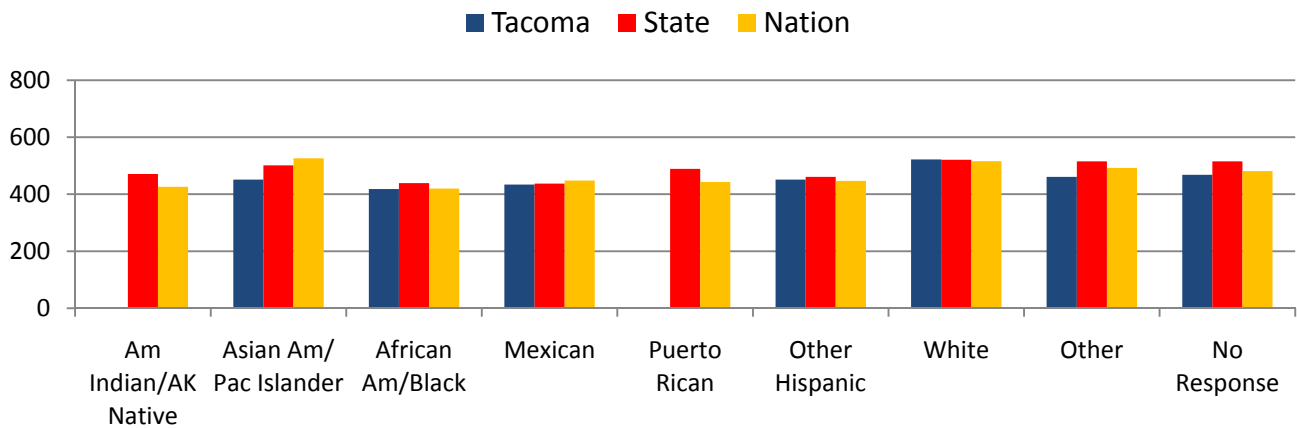

(Disaggregated by Gender)

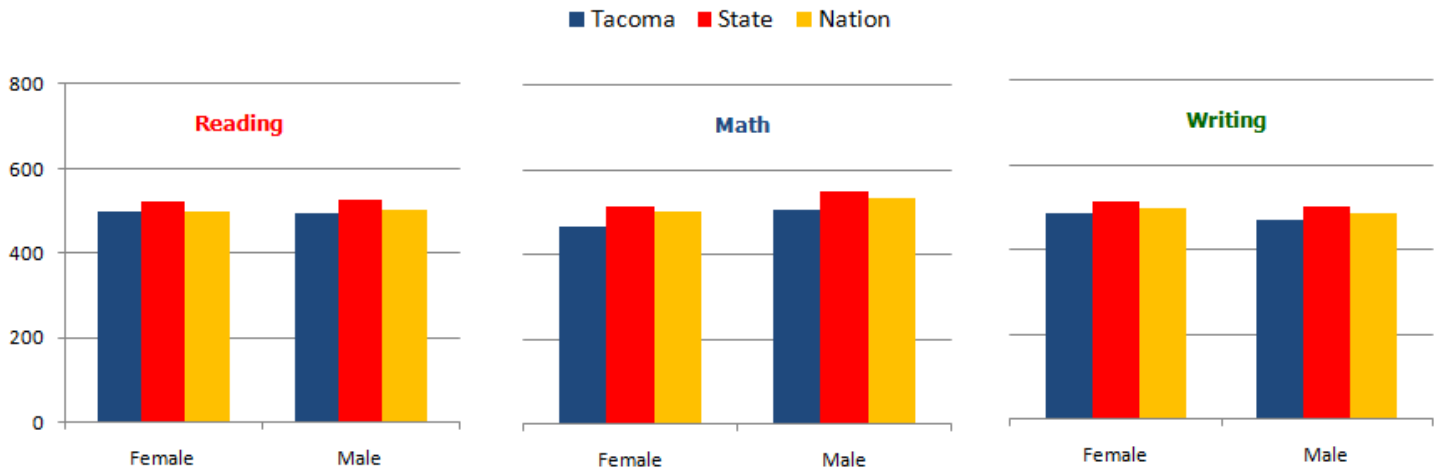
