# New! Required field on Diploma screen for high school students.

The Expected Graduation Year and 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Entry Date will be pre-set during year-end transition for all 9<sup>th</sup> grade students entering High School. You will need to manually input this data for students entering your building from out-of-district. The Graduation Requirement field will be automatically populated in the evening based upon the 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Entry Date. The state uses these dates to establish cohorts and determine on-time graduation rates.
