## SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION BULLETIN LEVEL 2 NOTIFICATION OF RELEASE (MODERATE RISK TO RE-OFFEND)

The Tacoma Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.550 and the Washington State Supreme Court decision in State v. Ward, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when; in the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the sheriff's office in the county of their residence. Further, their previous criminal history places them in a classification level which reflects the potential to re-offend. This sex offender has served the sentence imposed by the courts **AND IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME.**

The *TACOMA POLICE DEPARTMENT* has no legal authority to direct where a sex offender may or may not live. Constructive community action through reporting parole violations is beneficial, but abuse of information through harassment, threats or intimidation could jeopardize the community notification process and will not be tolerated. It is our belief that an informed public is a safer public, and we advocate the responsible use of the following information.

On January 11, 2012 the following offender registered to live in the 6800 block of South Warner Street, in the City of Tacoma.



## Damon Williams

Black Male

Age: 30

Hair: Black Eyes: Brown

Height: 6'06" Weight: 220-lbs

In 1998, WILLIAMS was convicted of **Rape 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree** and **Incest 1<sup>st</sup> Degree** in Pierce County. According to official file documents, WILLIAMS (age 14 to 17) sexually assaulted a familial female (age 12 to 15). In 1994, WILLIAMS was convicted of **Sexual Misconduct 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree** in Detroit, Michigan. WILLIAMS (age 12) sexually assaulted a familial male (age 4). In 2008 WILLIAMS was convicted of **Failure to Register as a Sex Offender** in Pierce County. WILLIAMS did not participate in a Sex Offender Treatment Program during his recent incarceration. WILLIAMS is required to report any change of address, employment, and school enrollment to the Pierce County Sheriff Department.

As of the date of this bulletin, there are 566,782 offenders who have registered to live in the United States. There are approximately 18,885 sex offenders who have registered as required and are living in the State of Washington. In the City of Tacoma, there are approximately 925 offenders who have registered. There are approximately 2,900 sex offenders who have registered with the Pierce County Sheriff Department.
