Uniform Policy

Uniform Tops

All uniform tops must be
Solid White, Navy or Dark Green

- Shirts/Blouses
 - Polo Style – Must have collar
 - Blouse – Must have collar
 - Mock Turtleneck or Turtleneck
- Sweaters & Vests
 - Long or Short Sleeve
 - Crew, V-neck, Collared or Cardigan
- Sweatshirts
 - Crew, Collared or Hood
 - Crescent Heights Sweatshirt
- Undershirts/Layering
 - All Shirts must be uniform color

Uniform Bottoms

All uniform bottoms must be
Navy Blue or Khaki Tan

- All pants must be worn on the waist and secured by a belt if necessary
- Shorts and skirts should be no more than 1" above the knee
- Navy blue or khaki tan skirts and jumpers may be worn with or without leggings
- Leggings must be solid blue or white and **only worn under skirts or jumpers**
- Uniform policy top must be worn underneath any jumper

Note: Sweatpants, sport pants or Jeans are **NOT** considered uniform appropriate

Shoes and Socks

- Shoes
 - Athletic or Tennis, Leather Type, Boots, etc.
 - *Sandals are not permitted*
- Socks
 - Socks or Tights must be worn daily

Coats and Jackets

Coats and Jackets will be worn to school, at recess and leaving school – they are not to be worn in class

Non Uniform Days

Spirit Friday - Every Friday of the Month – Students may wear any team/spirit wear tops. Uniform bottoms are required.

Free Dress Friday – The last Friday of every month students may wear Free Dress. Clothes need to be appropriate for school, in good condition and follow the same length guidelines in uniform wear.

Spirit Days – ASB and Staff will communicate spirit days as they happen during the year.

Unacceptable Clothing/Accessories

- Oversized, bagging and sagging clothing.
- Hats (of any kind)
- Revealing clothing
- Sandals/Flip Flops
- Make – Up
- Logos depicting - alcohol, tobacco, monsters, etc.
