

Washington-Hoyt Transportation and After-School Program Update

Thank you for taking the time to submit your feedback on the most recent transportation survey for Washington-Hoyt Elementary School. A preliminary plan for bus routes for the 2013-2014 school year includes three proposed bus routes from the Washington-Hoyt catchment area to Hunt Middle School, located at 6501 S. 10th St.

How to set up a weekly bus-ride schedule

Parents can set up a weekly bus-riding schedule that meets the needs of their family. Parents must sign-up at the main office at Washington-Hoyt and provide the location of the bus stop their student will be using. Parents can choose the number of weekdays their student will regularly ride the bus. This could be only one day a week or any combination of days, up to five days a week. Students can choose to ride the bus mornings or afternoons only, or take advantage of both.

Bus pick-up and drop-off information

The school buses will stop only at designated bus stops inside the Washington-Hoyt catchment area, as shown by the bold red line on the map included. Students who live outside of the catchment area can take a bus at the Washington-Hoyt catchment area bus stop most convenient for them.

The first morning bus will pick-up students at the bus stop at approximately 8:10 a.m. Please arrive at least five minutes early for a.m. pick-up and p.m. drop-off. Please remember parents will be responsible for taking their student to the bus stop before school and picking them up from the bus stop after school. Any questions may be directed to the Tacoma Public Schools Transportation Department at 253-571-1853. Buses are scheduled to arrive at Hunt at 8:45 a.m. and depart at 3:40 p.m.

After-school programs

Parents whose students attend band practice at Mason Middle School will continue to drop off their students at Mason and students will be bussed to Hunt after rehearsals. The Champions' After-School Daycare program will also move to the Hunt campus. Due to construction, there will be no student programs held at either the Washington or Hoyt buildings during the 2013-2014 school year.
