What is Summer Bridge?

- Summer Bridge is an opportunity for students to prepare for their challenging courses in the upcoming school year.
- This is designed for students who are taking their first advanced course but the information would be valuable to any student.
- This year we have developed 4 modules to help students think about their motivation and goals for their challenging courses.



What is Summer Bridge?

- This is the 5th year of summer bridge, but the first version completely on-line.
- The 4 modules can be done at the student's pace. Each module includes:
 - An introductory and overview video.
 - Some reading from the book 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens.
 - Additional resources to support students in their courses.
 - An end of module reflection for students to share what they have learned.
- Students completing all the modules will received recognition for their work.



What is Summer Bridge?

- The modules were developed based on the ideas in Culturally Relevant Teaching and the Brain, 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens, strategies from AVID, and other important ideas from brain science and learning.
- The goal of Summer Bridge and the modules is to help students move toward being independent, empowered learners that can be in control of and advocate for the own their own learning.

 - Begin With the End in Mind
 - Put First Things First
