

## SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

### Wilson High School

2016-17

#### TSD Strategic Goal 1: Academic Excellence

##### Target Area: 9<sup>th</sup> Grade

- % of students with three credits or more at the conclusion of first semester in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade year
- % of students with five credits or more at the conclusion of second semester in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade year
- % of students with five credits or more at the conclusion of summer quarter prior to the 10<sup>th</sup> grade year
- % students failing one class or more

##### Smart Goals:

1. In 2016-17, 88% of 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will pass ten or more classes total in the fall and spring semesters to gain five total credits and be at sophomore status for the 2017-2018 school year.
2. In 2016-17, 92% of 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will pass ten or more classes at the completion of the summer quarter to gain five total credits and be at sophomore status for the 2017-2018 school year.

\*Note: These percentages are developed utilizing pass data from the last three years.

##### Target Area: 10<sup>th</sup> Grade

- SBAC ELA: % of students meeting state graduation standard on state assessment

##### Smart Goals:

1. In 2016-17, 82% of Woodrow Wilson High School 10<sup>th</sup> graders will meet state graduation standard on SBAC ELA assessment.

Note: This is the third year of the SBAC ELA testing process for 10<sup>th</sup> graders. Our second year baseline score was 79% meeting state graduation standard.

##### Target Area: Graduation

- % of students graduating on time

##### Smart Goals:

1. 90% of the Class of 2017 will graduate on time using June 2017 data points.
2. 93% of the Class of 2017 will graduate, with extended time using October of 2017 data points.

##### Target Area: Students Prepared for Life after High School

- Number of VANI letters

##### Smart Goals:

1. The number of VANI letters submitted by seniors will maintain at or near our current rate of 97% in the spring of 2017.

Note: 57% completion in 2014, 84% in 2015, 97% in 2016.

##### Target Area: Eligibility/Readiness

- % of students taking at least one Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), Running Start, College in the High School (CIHS) course.

##### Smart Goals:

- 97% of students in the Class of 2016 will submit district accepted VANI options.
- In 2016-17, 100% of our eligible 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will have taken at least one Advanced Placement or College in a High School class.

**Smart Goals:**

1. In 2016-17, the number of 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students with one or more disciplinary infractions will decrease by 10%.
2. In 2016-17, the number of 12<sup>th</sup> grade students involved in each area of the OSPI Behavior Matrix will decrease by 10%.
